### **MARKET COMMENTARY**

Nifty managed to settle above 10K mark at 10,066 level, up by 52 points, while Sensex closed at 32,325 level, up by 87 points on Friday.

Broader market indices also managed to end in the green zone. BSE Mid-cap index ended at 15,436 level, up by 0.66% while BSE Small-cap index ended at 15,926 level, up by 0.1%. India VIX closed at 11.33 down by 2.64%.

Nifty opened with marginal losses of 5 points and dipped from the psychologically important mark of 10K mark during the day to touch its intraday low of 9,988. However, in the closing hour, IOC, SBI, HDFC Bank and TCS contributed majorly to the market recovery.

Nifty likely to trade in the range of 9855-10178.

  - ➤ Dollar Rallies, Treasuries Falter on Strong Hiring: Markets Wrap: - The dollar rallied the most since January and Treasuries fell after hiring last month came in stronger than forecast, underpinning the case for tighter monetary policy. U.S. stocks headed for records.
  - > Forex Dollar rallies to 1-week highs on strong NFP report: - he dollar rallied to one-week highs against the other major currencies on Friday, boosted by the release of better-thanexpected employment data in the U.S. The U.S. Labor Department said the economy added 209,000 jobs last month, blowing past expectations for an increase of 183,000. The U.S. economy added 231,000 jobs in June, whose figure was revised from a previously estimated 222,000 rise. The unemployment rate ticked down to 4.3% in July from 4.4% the previous month, in line with expectations. The report also showed that average hourly earnings increased by 0.3% last month, in line with forecasts and after a 0.2% gain in June.
  - Oil bulls aren't out of the woods yet:
    - Oil investors seem to buy the idea that recovery is finally underway after three years of gluts, but a price boom seems unlikely as the options market shows that at least until OPEC's supply deal expires, producers will pounce on any rallies.
