MARKET COMMENTARY

Monday's trade witnessed strong bullish sentiments in the broader market indices as they soared over 2%. Meanwhile, the benchmark indices also held on to their gains.

Nifty showcased see-saw movements, while breaching the 9,800 mark and ended lower at 9,794 level, gaining 83 points or 0.86%. Sensex posted its biggest single-day gain in a month closing higher at 31,449 level, up by 235 points or 0.75%.

The Nifty Midcap index also posted its biggest single-day gain in a month since October 2016. While BSE Mid-cap index closed higher by 2.49% at 15,092. BSE Small-cap index closed higher by 2.51% at 15,413. India VIX closed lower by 5.3% at 14.3.

There were 1,217 advances, 257 declines and 24 unchanged stocks on NSE, reflecting a positive undertone floating in the market.

Nifty likely to trade in the range of 9765-9910.

 - Stocks Bounce and Havens Drop as Korea Fears Abate: Markets Wrap: -The risk-off mood that gripped markets last week showed signs of easing, with shares in Europe following Asian equities higher and American stock futures advancing as the prospect of a war between the U.S. and North Korea receded. Havens including gold, Treasuries and the yen fell.
 - ▶ Dollar holds onto gains vs. rivals in quiet trade: The dollar held onto gains against the other major currencies on Monday, as markets continued to digest Friday's U.S. inflation data and as geopolitical tensions between the U.S. and North Korea seemed to die down. Trading was expected to remain quiet with no major U.S. economic reports set to be released throughout the day. The greenback had weakened broadly on Friday after the U.S. Commerce Department said consumer prices rose less-than-expected last month.
 - ▶ Gold starts the week with losses as U.S.-North Korea stand-off calms: Gold prices retreated from their highest level in around two months on Monday, as geopolitical concerns eased after senior U.S. officials sought to play down risks of a military conflict with North Korea. Geopolitical concerns appeared to fade as U.S. Secretary of Defense Jim Mattis and Secretary of State Rex Tillerson both said on Sunday that the Trump administration would continue to seek diplomatic resolutions with Pyongyang.
