MARKET COMMENTARY

Nifty 50 index rose 63.40 points or 0.62% to settle at 10,230.85, its record closing high. The index advanced 75.50 points or 0.74% at the day's high of 10,242.95, its record high. The index rose 7.65 points or 0.07% at the day's low of 10,175.10.

Sensex rose 200.95 points or 0.62% to settle at 32,633.64, its record closing high. The index advanced 254.63 points or 0.78% at the day's high of 32,687.32, its record high. The index rose 12.74 points or 0.03% at the day's low of 32,445.43.

Telecom stocks gained. Idea Cellular (up 5.26%) and Bharti Infratel (up 3.81%) advanced. Reliance Communications fell 1.11%

Private sector banks were mixed. ICICI Bank (up 0.98%), RBL Bank (up 0.67%), Kotak Mahindra Bank (up 0.55%), City Union Bank (up 0.41%) and HDFC Bank (up 0.20%), edged higher. Yes Bank (down 0.57%) and Axis Bank (down 1.65%), edged lower.

 - ➤ Dollar Gains as Treasuries Fall While Oil Surges: Markets Wrap: The dollar strengthened and Treasuries fell after Federal Reserve Chair Janet Yellen suggested gradual rate increases are warranted despite soft inflation. Gains in oil and copper drove a gauge of commodities to a seven-month high. The S&P 500 Index climbed to a record, led by technology and energy shares.
 - Copper surges above \$7K to fresh three-year high as rally gathers steam: Copper prices push to new three-year highs, breaking through the \$7K/ton psychological barrier following data that suggests China's economy is defying expectations of a slowdown.
 - Oil rises as fighting escalates in Iraq's oil-rich Kirkuk: - Oil markets jumped on Monday as Iraqi forces entered the oil city of Kirkuk, taking territory from Kurdish fighters and raising concerns over exports from OPEC's second-largest producer.
 - Natural Gas Futures Start the Week on the Back foot: - U.S. natural gas futures started the week on a downbeat note on Monday, pulling back from a two-week high, as traders reacted to forecasts showing a return to mild weather after a cold spell in the eastern U.S.
 - ➢ Gold Prices Rise to 3-Week Top, Firming Above \$1,300-Level: - Gold prices started the week on an upbeat note on Monday, supported by safehaven demand as conflict between Iraqi and Kurdish forces broke out near the oil-rich city of Kirkuk. The fighting follows a referendum in which the Kurds, who run their own semiautonomous region in northern Iraq, voted overwhelmingly in favor of independence, defying Baghdad, regional powers and the U.S.
