MARKET COMMENTARY

Nifty 50 index rose 3.60 points or 0.04% to settle at 10,234.45, its record high closing level. The index rose 21 points, or 0.21% at the day's high of 10,251.85, its record high. The index fell 18.25 points, or 0.18% at the day's low of 10,212.60.

Sensex fell 24.48 points or 0.08% to settle at 32,609.16, its lowest closing level since 13 October 2017. The index rose 66.22 points, or 0.20% at the day's high of 32,699.86, its record high. The index fell 76.90 points, or 0.24% at the day's low of 32,556.74S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.40%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index advanced 0.53%. Both the indices outperformed the Sensex.

On the BSE, 1,375 shares rose and 1,301 shares declined. A total of 129 shares were unchanged.

Indices closed the range-bound trading session near the flat line. The barometer index, the S&P BSE Sensex, fell 24.48 points or 0.08% to settle at 32,609.16. The Nifty 50 index rose 3.60 points or 0.04% to settle at 10,234.45. Both the Sensex and the Nifty hit record highs in intraday trade. The Nifty settled at a record high level. Nifty likely to trade in the range of 10115-10350


