MARKET COMMENTARY

The barometer index, the S&P BSE Sensex jumped 435.16 points or 1.33% to settle at 33,042.50. The Nifty 50 index rose 87.65 points or 0.86% to settle at 10,295.35. Both the Sensex and the Nifty, hit record closing highs. Nifty rose 87.65 points or 0.86% to settle at 10,295.35, a record closing high. The index spurted 132.85 points or 1.3% at the day's high of 10,340.55. The index gained 33.20 points or 0.32% at the day's low of 10,240.90

Sensex jumped 435.16 points or 1.33% to settle at 33,042.50, a record closing high. The index jumped 509.99 points or 1.56% at the day's high of 33,117.33. The index gained 197.26 points or 0.6% at the day's low of 32,804.60.

Indicating the overall health of the market, was negative. On the BSE, 1,532 shares fell and 1,160 shares rose. A total of 137 shares were unchanged.

The total turnover on BSE amounted to Rs 6011.79 crore, higher than turnover of Rs 4000.49 crore registered during the previous trading session
