MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex fell 227.80 points or 0.68% to settle at 33,227.99, its lowest closing level since 7 December 2017. The index rose 2.62 points, or 0.01% at the day's high of 33,458.41. The index fell 276.04 points, or 0.83% at the day's low of 33,179.75.

The Nifty 50 index fell 82.10 points or 0.80% to settle at 10,240.15, its lowest closing level since 7 December 2017. The index rose 3.85 points, or 0.04% at the day's high of 10,326.10. The index fell 92.05 points, or 0.89% at the day's low of 10,230.20.

Among secondary indices, the S&P BSE Mid-Cap index fell 1.01%, underperforming the Sensex. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index fell 0.68%, matching Sensex's slide in percentage terms.

The breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was weak. On the BSE, 1,701 shares declined and 982 shares rose. A total of 146 shares were unchanged.

 Wrap: U.S. stocks fluctuated, the
 dollar advanced and Treasuries slipped
 after data showed signs of inflation in
 producer prices as the Federal Reserve
 starts its two-day meeting.
 - Dollar Holds Steady Ahead of Fed Meeting: - The dollar was steady against a basket of the other major currencies on Tuesday ahead of a twoday meeting of the Federal Reserve where it is widely expected to raise interest rates for the fifth time since 2015.
 - ➢ Gold Prices Remain 5-Month Lows with Fed in Focus: Gold prices remained at five-month lows on Tuesday, as investors continued to focus on the Federal Reserve's upcoming policy decision this week The Fed is widely expected to raise interest rates at its two-day policy meeting that will end on Wednesday and is currently seen tightening two to three times next year, but concerns over tepid inflation could alter the outlook for 2018. Gold is sensitive to moves in U.S. rates, as a rise lifts the opportunity cost of holding non-yielding assets such as bullion.
 - Oil tops \$65, first time since 2015, on UK pipeline outage: Oil rose above \$65 a barrel for the first time since mid-2015 on Tuesday following a shutdown of the UK's biggest North Sea oil pipeline, which helps set the benchmark for global prices. The Forties pipeline, which was scheduled to pump 406,000 barrels per day (bpd) in December, was shut down on Monday after cracks were found in what traders believe is the first unplanned outage for some years.


