MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex lost 244.08 points or 0.72% to settle at 33,812.75, its lowest closing level since 21 December 2017. The Sensex lost 290.68 points, or 0.85%, at the day's low of 33,766.15 in late trade. The index rose 44.30 points, or 0.13%, at the day's high of 34,101.13 in early trade.


The Nifty 50 index lost 95.15 points or 0.9% to settle at 10,435.55, its lowest closing level since 18 December 2017. The Nifty fell 107.60 points, or 1.02%, at the day's low of 10,423.10 in late trade. The index advanced 7.15 points, or 0.06%, at the day's high of 10,537.85 in early trade.

Among the secondary indices, the S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.08%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index advanced 0.26%. Both these indices outperformed the Sensex.

The breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was positive. On the BSE, 1,633 shares advanced and 1,233 shares declined. A total of 184 shares were unchanged.

 - ➢ Oil Resurrection Sets Stage for Another OPEC-Shale Clash in 2018: -Oil continued its revival from the biggest crash in a generation, with prices set for a second annual gain after a year marked by hurricanes, Middle East conflict and the tussle between OPEC and U.S. shale. Futures are up more than 12 percent in 2017, having entered a bull market in September. In 2018, investors will watch whether rising prices trigger a new flood of U.S. output.
 - ▶ U.S. Stocks Fall as Euro Seeks Best Year Since '03: Markets Wrap: - U.S. stocks slipped in thin trading on the final market day of 2017, while the dollar's slump continued as the euro headed for its best annual performance in 14 years.
 - Forex- Dollar Falls to Three-Month
 Low: The dollar continued its holiday
 lull against other major currencies on
 Friday, the last trading day of the year.
 Trading volumes are expected to remain
 thin ahead of the New Year's Day
 holiday weekend. The greenback fell for
 the fourth consecutive day and was at
 its lowest level since the end of
 September. Some analysts think the
 weakness is due to sell offs after
 President Donald Trump signed the tax
 bill into law. The index was down 0.10%
 year-to-date.
 - Gold soars toward largest annual gain since 2010 on dollar boost: Gold extended its rally to a three-month high on Friday, leaping toward its biggest one-year rise in seven years as a wilting U.S. dollar, political tensions and receding concerns over the impact of U.S. interest rate hikes fed into its rally. Gold's gains coincide with the greenback, in which gold is priced, sliding toward its worst year since 2003,


