## **MARKET COMMENTARY**

The Sensex fell 0.49 points to settle at 33,812.26, its lowest closing level since 21 December 2017. The Sensex rose 151.39 points, or 0.45% at the day's high of 33,964.14 in early trade. The index fell 109.38 points, or 0.32% at the day's low of 33,703.37 in mid-afternoon trade.

The Nifty 50 index rose 6.65 points or 0.06% to settle at 10,442.20, its highest closing level since 29 December 2017. The Nifty rose 59.65 points, or 0.57% at the day's high of 10,495.20 in early trade. The index fell 30.90 points, or 0.30% at the day's low of 10,404.65 in mid-afternoon trade.

Among secondary barometers, the BSE Mid-Cap index fell 0.62%. The BSE Small-Cap index fell 0.63%. Both these indices underperformed the Sensex.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was negative. On BSE, 1,689 shares fell and 1,152 shares rose. A total of 113 shares were unchanged. Breadth was strong in early trade. Nifty likely to trade in the range of 10250-10650.

  - ➤ Dollar Extends Decline; European Stocks Slide: Markets Wrap: The dollar weakened against all G-10 peers, U.S. stocks rose and Treasuries fell in the first official day of trading in 2018. European stocks started the year in the red, failing to capitalize on a positive Asian session as the strength of the region's common currency weighed on exporters.
  - Forex Euro Hits 4-Month Highs against Broadly Weaker Dollar: The euro rose to the highest levels in four months against the broadly weaker dollar in the first trading day of the year on Tuesday and was in striking distance of its 2017 peak against the greenback. The euro zone manufacturing sector ended 2017 by ramping up activity at the fastest pace in more than two decades, according to data released on Tuesday and rising demand indicated that it will start the new year on a high.
  - ➤ Crude Oil Prices Pull Back but Remain Supported: - Crude oil prices pulled back on Tuesday, but remained supported near multi-year highs amid mounting unrest in Iran and as supply cut efforts by global oil producers continued to support. Iranian protesters attacked police stations late Monday, in their fourth day of demonstrations marking the biggest challenge to the country's clerical leadership since 2009.
