- **Tata Motors**' Jaguar Land Rover sales in December rose 0.6 percent to 55,697 units. Full year sales up 6.5 percent to 6.2 lakh units.
- Government to sell 1.5 percent stake in **NMDC** through an offer for sale at floor price of Rs 153.50 per share.
- Aarti Drugs to buyback 2.75 lakh shares (1.15 percent) at Rs 875 per share.
- Bharti Airtel says its payments bank has terminated some retailers.
- **Sutlej Textiles** and Industries to set up a plant in Jammu and Kashmir to manufacture polyester staple fibre. It also deferred plans of expanding its Baddi facility due to uncertain markets conditions in the yarn segment.

- Sun Pharma hikes stake in Ranbaxy Malaysia to 85.9 percent from 79.55 percent.

MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex rose 198.94 points or 0.58% to settle at 34,352.79, its record closing high. The index rose 231.82 points, or 0.68% at the day's high of 34,385.67, its record high level. The index rose 62.48 points, or 0.18% at the day's low of 34,216.33.

The Nifty 50 index rose 64.75 points or 0.61% to settle at 10,623.60, its record closing high. The index rose 72.35 points, or 0.69% at the day's high of 10,631.20, its record high level. The index rose 29.70 points, or 0.28% at the day's low of 10,588.55.

Among secondary indices, the S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.98%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index advanced 0.97%. Both these indices outperformed the Sensex.

The breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was strong. On the BSE, 1,774 shares advanced and 1,167 shares declined. A total of 179 shares were unchanged.

 - ▶ U.S. Stocks Mixed as Dollar Gains with Crude Oil: Markets Wrap: U.S. stocks were mixed, with the S&P 500 Index down after its best week in more than a year, as investors assessed the prospects for corporate earnings, while the dollar strengthened after three straight weekly declines.
 - ➤ Forex Dollar Extends Gains, Euro
 Pauses after Recent Rally: The
 dollar extended gains against a basket
 of the other major currencies on Monday
 after data showing weaker than
 expected U.S. jobs growth last month
 did little to alter expectations for further
 Federal Reserve rate hikes this year.
 - Gold Prices Remain Lower on Stronger U.S. Dollar: Gold prices remained lower on Monday, as expectations for upcoming U.S. rate hikes lent support to the dollar despite last Friday's disappointing U.S. employment data. The greenback found support after San Francisco Fed President John Williams said on Saturday that the Fed should raise interest rates three times this year given that economy will benefit from tax cuts. The comments came a day after Cleveland Fed President Loretta Mester said she expects about four interest rate hikes this year, thanks to solid U.S. economic growth and low unemployment.
 - ➤ U.S. offers drillers nearly all offshore waters, but focus is on eastern Gulf: President Donald Trump's administration has proposed opening up nearly all of America's offshore waters to oil and gas drilling, but the industry says it is mainly interested in one part of it, now cordoned off by the Pentagon: the eastern Gulf of Mexico.
