MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex lost 72.46 points or 0.21% to settle at 34,771.05, its lowest closing level since 12 January 2018. The Sensex rose 92.52 points or 0.27% at the day's high of 34,936.03 in morning trade. The index fell 107.96 points or 0.31% at the day's low of 34,735.55 in mid-afternoon trade.

The Nifty 50 index lost 41.10 points or 0.38% to settle at 10,700.45, its lowest closing level since 12 January 2018. The Nifty gained 20.80 points or 0.19% at the day's high of 10,762.35 in morning trade. The index declined 53.70 points or 0.5% at the day's low of 10,687.85 in mid-afternoon trade, its lowest level since 12 January 2018.

Among the secondary indices, the S&P BSE Mid-Cap index fell 1.74%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index dropped 2.21%. Both these indices underperformed the Sensex.

The total turnover on BSE amounted to Rs 7648.82 crore, higher than turnover of Rs 5271.95 crore registered during the previous trading session.

 - ➤ Stocks Race to Records as Big Banks Show Strength: Markets Wrap: The U.S. stocks jumped to records with the Dow Jones Industrial Average crossing 26,000 and S&P 500 Index surpassing 2,800, both for the first time, as Citigroup Inc. discussed possible significant investor payouts from the bank's windfall stemming from a major tax cut.
 - Forex Dollar Regains Ground as Euro Retreats from Three-Year High:
 - The dollar pushed higher against a basket of the other major currencies on Tuesday as the euro pulled back from three-year highs scaled amid growing expectations that the European Central Bank could pare back its monetary stimulus this year.
 - ▶ Brent oil falls by \$1 but demand underpins near \$70/barrel: Brent crude oil shed some of its recent gains by falling just over \$1 a barrel on Tuesday but healthy demand underpinned prices near \$70, a level not seen since 2014's market slump. Prices have been driven up by oil production curbs in OPEC nations and Russia, as well as strong demand thanks to healthy economic growth.
 - Copper Falls Most in 6 Weeks as
 Metals Rally Starts to Give: After a
 non-stop rally, metals prices are starting
 to pull back. Copper, aluminum and
 nickel slid more than 2 percent on
 Tuesday as investors focused on the
 rebounding dollar and evidence of ample
 supply in the physical market. Precious
 metals also retreated, with silver falling
 as much as 3.2 percent.

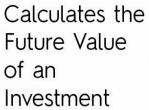
