MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex jumped 347.56 points or 1% at the day's high of 35,118.61 in late trade. The index fell 70.23 points or 0.2% at the day's low of 34,700.82 in early trade.

The Nifty 50 index surged 88.10 points or 0.82% to settle at 10,788.55, its record closing high. The Nifty gained 102.55 points or 0.95% at the day's high of 10,803 in late trade. The index declined 33.70 points or 0.31% at the day's low of 10,666.75 in early trade.

Among the secondary indices, the S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.66%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index rose 0.43%. Both these indices underperformed the Sensex. The side indices recovered after witnessing sharp fall earlier during the session.

The market breadth indicating health of the market was turned positive from negative in late trade. On the BSE, 1,456 shares rose and 1,437 shares fell. A total of 154 shares were unchanged.


