MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex gained 178.47 points or 0.51% to settle at 35,260.29, a record closing high. The index gained 425.54 points or 1.21% at the day's high of 35,507.36. The index rose 84.62 points or 0.24% at the day's low of 35,166.44.

The Nifty advanced 28.45 points or 0.26% to settle at 10,817, a record closing high. The index gained 98.95 points or 0.92% at the day's high of 10,887.50. The index fell 6.15 points or 0.06% at the day's low of 10,782.40.

The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index shed 1.69%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index dropped 2.04%. Both these indices underperformed the Sensex.

The breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was weak. On the BSE, 2,262 shares declined and 696 shares rose. A total of 128 shares were unchanged.

 - ▶ U.S. Stocks Slide Following Wednesday's Records: Markets Wrap: - U.S. stocks retreated after hitting all-time highs on Wednesday. The yield on 10-year Treasuries climbed above 2.6 percent for the first time since March, while the dollar failed to hold the previous day's gain.
 - > FOREX-Dollar falls on worries over possible U.S. government shutdown:
 - The U.S. dollar fell on Thursday as traders piled into the euro, yen, sterling and other major currencies amid concerns over a possible U.S. government shutdown as lawmakers struggled to cobble together a federal budget deal. If an agreement to fund government operations, even a temporary one, is not reached by the Friday deadline, it would compound an already-negative climate for the greenback, analysts said. The dollar has fallen since 2017 largely on expectations central banks besides the Federal Reserve are seeking to end the extraordinary measures they adopted to combat the 2008 global financial crisis and the recession that followed.
 - ➤ WTI Oil Futures Pare Losses After Crude Inventories: West Texas Intermediate oil pared losses in North American trade on Thursday in what was an initial reaction after data that showed that oil supplies in the U.S. registered a larger-than-expected inventory draw. The U.S. Energy Information Administration said in its weekly report that crude oil inventories fell by 6.861 million barrels in the week ended January 12. Market analysts had expected a crude-stock draw of 3.536 million barrels.
