MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex fell 407.40 points or 1.18% to settle at 34,005.76, its lowest closing level since 4 January 2018. The index tumbled 563.51 points, or 1.63%, at the day's low of 33,849.65. The index declined 342.43 points, or 0.99%, at the day's high of 34,070.73.

The Nifty declined 121.90 points or 1.15% to settle at 10,454.95, its lowest closing level since 3 January 2018. The index tanked 178.65 points, or 1.68%, at the day's low of 10,398.20. The index fell 96.65 points, or 0.91%, at the day's high of 10,480.20.

Among secondary indices, the S&P BSE Mid-Cap index fell 0.09%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index advanced 0.23%. Both these indices outperformed the Sensex.

The breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was positive. On the BSE, 1,404 shares advanced and 1,370 shares declined. A total of 136 shares were unchanged.

 - ➤ Global Stock Turmoil Persists Amid Rate Jitters: Markets Wrap: - The convulsions rocking U.S. equity markets continued Friday, with major indexes headed for the worst week in almost seven years after falling back from early gains. Treasury declines eased as investors sought havens from gold to the yen.
 - Forex Dollar Turns Higher as U.S. Shutdown Ends: The U.S. dollar turned higher against other major currencies on Friday, after the U.S. Congress managed to pass a two-year budget agreement, ending a brief government shutdown. The agreement will boost federal spending by almost \$300 billion and suspend the debt ceiling for a year.
 - Oil Drops Below \$60 as U.S. Shale `Backlash' Rattles Traders: - Crude dropped below \$60 a barrel for the first time this year as the worst collapse in equities in years compounded concern that unprecedented supply growth from U.S. oil fields will overwhelm demand. Futures tumbled as much as 2.4 percent on Friday in New York, on track for its steepest weekly decline in almost a year. A global index of more than 1,600 stocks limped toward its most painful weekly result since 2011 as investors fled riskier asset classes.
 - ➢ Gold Prices Little Changed as U.S. Dollar Retreats, Bond Yields Rise: -Gold prices were little changed on Friday, as the U.S. dollar declined following news of another U.S. government shutdown although a budget bill was expected to be passed before the weekend, while U.S. bond yields turned back higher.


