MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex rose 141.27 points or 0.42% to settle at 33,844.86, its highest closing level since 16 February 2018. The index gained 207.77 points or 0.62% at the day's high of 33,911.36. The index fell 1.09 points at the day's low of 33,702.50.

The Nifty 50 index rose 37.05 points or 0.36% to settle at 10,397.45, its highest closing level since 16 February 2018. The index gained 65.70 points or 0.63% at the day's high of 10,426.10. The index fell 10.80 points or 0.1% at the day's low of 10,349.60.

The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index fell 0.05%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index slipped 0.17%. Both these indices underperformed the Sensex

 - Forex Dollar Steady at 1-Week Highs as Fed Minutes Eyed: The dollar was trading at one-week highs against a currency basket on Wednesday, as investors awaited the minutes of the Federal Reserve's latest policy meeting for fresh indications on the future pace of interest rate hikes. The index has climbed higher after it sank to a low of 88.15 on Friday, the weakest since December 2014.
 - Natural Gas Futures Continue Higher for Second Straight Day: - Natural gas futures continued higher for the second day in a row on Wednesday, nearing their best level in almost two weeks, amid forecasts for a bump in late-winter heating demand.
 - Crude Oil Prices Still on the
 Downside Ahead of Supply Data: Crude oil prices remained lower on
 Wednesday, weighed by U.S. dollar
 strength and amid growing caution
 ahead of this week's U.S. supply data.
 U.S. crude oil futures were boosted on
 Tuesday as a result of reduced flows
 from Canada's Keystone pipeline, which
 has been operating below capacity since
 late last year due to a leak.
 - ➢ Gold Prices Remain Under Pressure Ahead of Fed Minutes: - Gold prices remained under pressure on Wednesday, hovering at one-week lows as the U.S. dollar continued to be supported ahead of the minutes of the Federal Reserve's latest policy meeting.


