- NMDC cut lump ore prices by 3.2 percent, and fine prices by 3.62 percent.
- **Wipro** to acquire 33.33 percent stake in the U.S. based application security solution provider, Denim group for \$8.8 million.
- Punjab National Bank raised interest rates by 10-45 basis points on various tenures.
- **Dilip Buildcon** received Letter of Award by NHAI for two new hybrid annuity projects in Karnataka worth Rs 4,473 crore.
- JBM Auto board approved scheme of amalgamation of JBM Auto Systems and JBM MA Automotive with self.

MARKET COMMENTARY


The Sensex fell 137.10 points or 0.40% to settle at 34,046.94, its lowest closing level since 22 February 2018. The index rose 94.59 points, or 0.28% at the day's high of 34,278.63. The index fell 168.25 points, or 0.49% at the day's low of 34,015.79.

The Nifty 50 index fell 34.50 points or 0.33% to settle at 10,458.35, its lowest closing level since 22 February 2018. The index rose 32.65 points, or 0.31% at the day's high of 10,525.50. The index fell 45.70 points, or 0.44% at the day's low of 10,447.15.

Among secondary barometers, the BSE Mid-Cap index fell 0.61%, underperforming the Sensex. The BSE Small-Cap index fell 0.24%, outperforming the Sensex.

 - > Stocks Mixed as Market Shrugs Off Trump, Fed Fears: Markets Wrap: U.S. stocks were mixed Friday, with mega caps bearing the brunt of selling and small capitalization shares rallying, while Treasuries slipped with the dollar as investors assessed the impact of a potential trade war.
 - > Forex Dollar Pushes Lower on U.S. Policy Concerns: - The U.S. dollar pushed lower against other major currencies on Friday, as worries over a potential global trade war following news of fresh U.S. tariffs continued to weigh on heavily sentiment. U.S. President Donald Trump announced plans on Thursday to impose tariffs of 25% on imported steel and 10% on aluminum, in a move to "protect U.S. industry". The news sparked concerns over potential trade wars, which would have a negative impact on the U.S. economy. The announcement overshadowed positive remarks by Fed Chair Powell, who told the Senate Banking Committee on Thursday that there was no evidence the U.S. economy is overheating.
 - ➢ Gold Prices Remain Supported in Risk-Off Trade: - Gold prices remained supported on Friday, as news of U.S. tariffs on steel and aluminum imports continued to weigh on the greenback and boost demand for safe-haven assets.
 - Crude Oil Prices Remain Lower in Cautious Trade: - Crude oil prices remained lower on Friday, hovering near multi-week troughs amid ongoing concerns over U.S. production levels and fresh worries over U.S. protectionist policies.

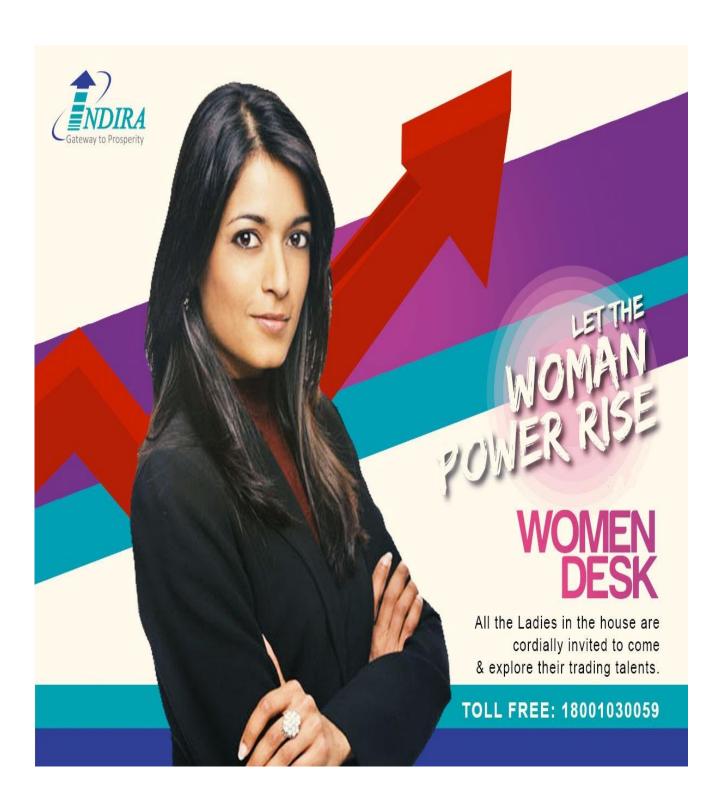
