MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex fell 150.20 points or 0.44% to settle at 33,685.54, its lowest closing level since 9 March 2018. The index gained 30.54 points, or 0.09%, at the day's high of 33,866.28. The index lost 198.46 points, or 0.59%, at the day's low of 33,637.28.

The Nifty declined 50.75 points or 0.49% to settle at 10,360.15, its lowest closing level since 9 March 2018. The index gained 9.10 points, or 0.09%, at the day's high of 10,420. The index lost 64.70 points, or 0.62%, at the day's low of 10,346.20.

Among secondary indices, the S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.49%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index advanced 0.8%. Both these indices outperformed the Sensex.

The breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was strong. On the BSE, 1,640 shares advanced and 1,045 shares declined. A total of 162 shares were unchanged.

 - Stocks Rise, Bonds Steady on Factory, Jobs Data: Markets Wrap: -Stocks in the U.S. pushed higher as traders look forward to next week's Federal Reserve policy decision. Tenyear Treasury yields steadied after briefly drifting below 2.80 percent.
 - Forex Dollar Pushes Higher after U.S. Import Price Data: The dollar pushed higher against a currency basket on Thursday, boosted by data showing that U.S. import prices rose more than forecast in February, fueling expectations for a pickup in inflation this year. The dollar found some support after the Labor Department reported that import prices rose 0.4% last month, compared to forecasts for a more modest increase of 0.3%.
 - ➢ Gold Prices Turn Lower as U.S. Dollar Rebounds: - Gold prices turned lower on Thursday, as the release of mostly positive U.S. data pushed the greenback higher, although concerns over protectionist U.S. policies and fresh turmoil in Washington continued to linger.
 - ➤ Crude Oil Prices Bounce Back on Upbeat Demand Outlook: Crude oil prices bounced higher on Thursday, erasing earlier losses, after the International Energy Agency forecast an increase in global oil demand for the next year, although it also warned about the consequences of protectionist U.S. policies.
 - ➤ Natural Gas Futures Extend Losses
 After Storage Data: The U.S. Energy
 Information Administration said in its
 weekly report that natural gas storage in
 the U.S. fell by 93 billion cubic feet in
 the week ended March 9, while analysts
 had forecast a decline of 96 billion.
