MARKET COMMENTARY

The S&P BSE Sensex, lost 95.12 points or 0.27% to settle at 35,227.26. The index hit high of 35,438.22 and low of 35,177.35 during the day.

The Nifty 50 index lost 39.95 points or 0.37% to settle at 10,696.20. The index hit high of 10,764.75 and low of 10,681.50 during the day.

The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index fell 1.01%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index fell 1.57%. Both these indices underperformed the Sensex.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was weak. On the BSE, 715 shares rose and 1984 shares fell. A total of 126 shares were unchanged.

 - Numbers Beat: Markets Wrap: Stocks rallied and bonds fell after the latest jobs data bolstered optimism in the economy, all but solidifying a rate hike later this month. The S&P 500 Index erased losses for the week after the unemployment rate fell to 3.8 percent, the lowest in nearly half a century. The dollar was set to push its weekly streak of gains to seven weeks, the most since 2014, while the 10-year Treasury yield rose above 2.90 percent as focus turned to the Federal Reserve's pace of rate increases.
 - ▶ Forex- U.S. Dollar Rises After Jobs Report: The dollar surged after the jobs report came in higher than expected while the euro was lower. The greenback was bolstered by news that the unemployment rate fell to its lowest level in 18 years and the economy added more jobs than expected. Nonfarm payrolls rose by 223,000 in May, according to official data released on Friday. The data was higher than the consensus estimate for the creation of 189,000 jobs and above the 178,000 positions that the ADP report indicated on Wednesday.

 After Jobs Report: Gold prices were lower on Friday, as the U.S. dollar strengthened after a better than expected jobs report. Nonfarm payrolls rose by 223,000 in May, according to official data released on Friday.
