MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex rose 83.31 points or 0.23% to settle at 35,657.86, its highest closing level since 22 June 2018. The index rose 225.16 points, or 0.63% at the day's high of 35,799.71. The index fell 42.34 points, or 0.12% at the day's low of 35,532.21.

The Nifty 50 index rose 22.90 points or 0.21% to settle at 10,772.65, its highest closing level since 22 June 2018. The index rose 66.60 points, or 0.62% at the day's high of 10,816.35. The index fell 14.70 points, or 0.14% at the day's low of 10,735.05.

Among secondary barometers, the BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.56%. The BSE Small-Cap index rose 0.46%. Both these indices outperformed the Sensex.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was positive. On BSE, 1,451 shares rose and 1,188 shares fell. A total of 142 shares were unchanged.

Nifty likely to trade in the range of 10650-10900.

 - Stocks Gain as Tech Strength Overwhelms Trade Fear: Markets Wrap: - U.S. stocks moved higher in light trading Friday driven by biotechnology shares following reports that Biogen Inc.'s Alzheimers drug showed positive results in a large clinical trial. The dollar extended losses and Treasuries climbed as investors assessed a mixed jobs report and the impact of an escalating trade rift with China.
 - Forex- Dollar Slumps as Trade Tariffs Kick in: - The U.S. dollar slumped on Friday as trade tariffs between the U.S. and China began while the pound gained steam. Trade conflict between the two biggest economies in the world began in force on Friday, when U.S. tariffs on \$34 billion worth of Chinese goods went into effect at 12:01 AM ET (04:01 GMT). Additional tariffs on another \$16 billion in goods are expected to go into effect in two weeks. Meanwhile, U.S. President Donald Trump has given instructions to identify tariffs on a further \$300 billion in possible Chinese goods. China has also retaliated with tariffs on \$34 billion of American goods, according to Xinhua news.
 - Gold Remains Lower After Jobs Report: - Gold prices remained lower on Friday as the U.S. dollar weakened and U.S. trade tariffs against China went into effect.
 - Oil slips below \$77, weighed down by Saudi output boost, trade tensions: - LONDON (Reuters) - Oil slipped below \$77 a barrel on Friday, under pressure from higher Saudi production and trade tensions between the United States and China, despite support from oil supply disruptions.
