MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex lost 356.46 points or 0.95% to settle at 37,165.16. The Sensex rose 8.07 points, or 0.02% at the day's high of 37,529.69 at the onset of trading session. The index fell 392.63 points, or 1.05% at the day's low of 37,128.99 in late trade.

The Nifty 50 index lost 101.50 points or 0.89% to settle at 11,244.70. The Nifty fell 17.30 points, or 0.15% at the day's high of 11,328.90 at the onset of trading session. The index fell 111.25 points, or 0.98% at the day's low of 11,234.95 in late trade.

Broader market bucked weak market trend. Among secondary barometers, the BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.09%. The BSE Small-Cap index rose 0.07%. Both these indices outperformed the Sensex.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was positive. On BSE, 1343 shares rose and 1325 shares fell. A total of 156 shares were unchanged.

 - Tech Stocks Rise on Earnings as Dollar Strengthens: Markets Wrap: -Tech stocks gained on favorable earnings reports, helping offset losses for exporters amid the Trump administration's latest threats to free trade. The dollar climbed and bonds were mixed after key central bank decisions.
 - Forex Dollar Broadly Higher, Pound at 2-Week Lows after BoE: - The dollar was broadly higher against a currency basket on Thursday a day after the Federal Reserve indicated that it is on track for additional rate hikes this year and as fresh concerns over trade tensions boosted safe haven demand.
 - Gold Falls as Dollar Strengthens: -Gold prices were down on Thursday as the dollar strengthened amid trade worries. The Fed left interest rates unchanged on Wednesday, as expected. But the central bank upgraded its view on the economy, as strong U.S. economic data support continuing gradual rate hikes. Higher rates are a negative for gold as the precious metal, which does not pay interest, struggles to compete with yield-bearing assets when rates rise.
 - Oil Prices Bounce, But Escalating Supply Worries Cap Gains: - Oil prices rebounded on Thursday, breaking a two-day losing streak, although concerns of escalating supply continued to cap gains.
 - Natural Gas Price Moves Higher on Small Increase to Storage: - The U.S. Energy Information Administration (EIA) reported Thursday morning that U.S. natural gas stockpiles increased by 35 billion cubic feet for the week ending

Arbitrage


Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
