MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex rose 221.76 points or 0.59% to settle at 37,887.56, its record closing high. The index rose 265.62 points, or 0.71% at the day's high of 37,931.42. The index fell 24.40 points, or 0.06% at the day's low of 37,641.40.

The Nifty 50 index rose 60.55 points or 0.53% to settle at 11,450, its record closing high. The index rose 70.50 points, or 0.62% at the day's high of 11,459.95. The index fell 10.15 points, or 0.09% at the day's low of 11,379.30.

The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.16%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index rose 0.03%. Both these indices underperformed the Sensex.

The broader market lagged the key indices. The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was negative. On the BSE, 1315 shares rose and 1422 shares fell. A total of 132 shares were unchanged.

 - U.S. Stocks Mixed Amid Trade Concern; Bonds Steady: Markets Wrap: - U.S. stocks erased early losses prompted by renewed trade fears as gains in mega cap technology shares left major benchmarks little changed. Oil slumped and Treasuries rose.
 - China Announces Date to Match \$16 Billion U.S. Tariffs: - Beijing to impose 25% additional tariffs on \$16b U.S. imports. China to raise tariffs on coal, medical instruments, cars. China confirmed that it will impose 25 percent tariffs on an additional \$16 billion worth of imports from the U.S. from Aug.23, matching an earlier move from Washington in another ratchet higher for the trade war between the two nations.
 - Forex Sterling Falls to 2018 Lows as Brexit Selloff Intensifies: - The pound fell to the lowest levels of the year on Wednesday as the currency was pressured lower by growing fears over the prospect of Britain exiting the European Union without a trade deal in place.
 - > Oil Extends Losses After Smaller Drawdown in Crude Inventories: -West Texas Intermediate oil extended losses in North American trade on Wednesday, as data showed that oil supplies in the U.S. fell less than expected. The U.S. Energy Information Administration said in its weekly report that crude oil inventories fell by 1.351 million barrels in the week ended Aug. 3. Market analysts had expected a crude-stock decline of 2.8 million barrels, while the American Petroleum Institute late Tuesday reported a decline of 6 million.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

This Trading algorithm is designed basically for jobbing:

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
