MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex rose 461.42 points or 1.35% to settle at 34,760.89, its highest closing level since 4 October 2018. The index rose 558.88 points, or 1.63% at the day's high of 34,858.35. The index rose 47.03 points, or 0.14% at the day's low of 34,346.50.

The Nifty 50 index rose 159.05 points or 1.54% to settle at 10,460.10, its highest closing level since 4 October 2018. The index rose 181.30 points, or 1.76% at the day's high of 10,482.35. The index rose 17.20 points, or 0.17% at the day's low of 10,318.25.

Among secondary barometers, the BSE Mid-Cap index rose 4.23%. The BSE Small-Cap index rose 3.67%. Both these indices outperformed the Sensex.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was strong. On BSE, 2060 shares rose and 606 shares fell. A total of 135 shares were unchanged.

 - > U.S. Stocks Fall Fifth Day as Treasuries Retreat: Markets Wrap: -A risk-off tone gripped financial markets, with U.S. stocks falling a fifth day as Treasury yields rose and the effects of the trade war with China starting to show up in corporate profits. Oil fell from \$75 a barrel even as a major hurricane headed for the Florida Panhandle.
 - > Forex Dollar Rally on Hold in Cautious Trade; Euro Steady: - A rally in the dollar paused on Wednesday, as U.S. Treasury yields held below their recent seven-year highs, but demand for the greenback continued to be underpinned by expectations for a potentially faster pace of rate hikes from the Federal Reserve.
 - Oil dips as IMF cuts growth outlook; eyes on hurricane: - Oil prices slipped on Wednesday after the IMF lowered its global growth forecasts, but markets were supported as Hurricane Michael moved toward Florida causing the shutdown of nearly 40 percent of U.S. Gulf of Mexico crude production.
 - > Gold Prices Flat as Dollar Takes a **Breather**: - Gold prices were largely unchanged Wednesday as investors grappled with rising U.S. interest rates, although the metal drew some support from the dollar coming off a seven-week high. Treasury yields have surged recently following a batch of upbeat economic data that bolstered the case for the Federal Reserve to raise rates in December and beyond. Expectations for rising interest rates look likely to remain a headwind for gold prices. Interest rate increases and higher U.S. bond yields dampen appeal for gold, which offers no yield.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

This Trading algorithm is designed basically for jobbing:

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
