- **Coal India**: Government will sell up to 18,62,22,275 (3 percent) equity shares of Coal India through offer for sale on October 31 and November 1, with an option to additionally sell 37,24,44,550 (6 percent) equity shares of the company. The floor price for the offer will be Rs 266 per share, a 3.6 percent discount to Tuesday's closing price.
- **Dr Reddy's Laboratories**: US FDA completed audit of Duvvada manufacturing facility with 8 observations.
- IL&FS Transportation: K Ramchand resigned as Managing Director of the company.
- Noida Toll Bridge: K Ramchand resigned from directorship of the company
- Punjab National Bank: Bank to hike MCLR by 5 bps across tenures effective November 1.
- IL&FS Transportation: Company defaulted on 6 NCD payments due on October 29 & 30
- **Garden Reach Shipbuilders & Engineers**: Company entered into a contract with the Government of India, Ministry of Defence, for construction and delivery of 04 Nos. Survey Vessels (Large) at an estimated cost of Rs 2,435.15 crore, under fixed price basis.
- **Kridhan Infra**: Singapore-based 100 percent subsidiary KH Foges has been awarded two new orders in Singapore worth \$\$ 24.63 million (Rs 130.5 crore).

MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex fell 176.27 points or 0.52% to settle at 33,891.13. The index hit high of 34,176.36 and low of 33,799.79 in intraday trade.

The Nifty 50 index fell 52.45 points or 0.51% to settle at 10,198.40. The index hit high of 10,285.10 and low of 10,175.35 in intraday trade.

Among secondary barometers, the BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.91%. The BSE Small-Cap index rose 0.94%. Both these indices outperformed the Sensex.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was positive. On BSE, 1479 shares rose and 1080 shares fell. A total of 150 shares were unchanged.

 - U.S. Stocks Rise in Volatile Trading, Bonds Drop: Markets Wrap: - U.S. stocks were turned higher as financial markets remained volatile amid a spate of mixed earnings and fresh data showing cracks in the housing market. Treasuries fell and the dollar rose.
 - Forex Dollar near 10-Week Highs amid Renewed Trade Concerns: -The dollar rose to near 10-week highs against a currency basket on Tuesday as heightened trade tensions exacerbated fears of a slowdown in global economic growth, bolstering safe haven demand.
 - Gold Prices Fall as Trade War **Tensions Boost Safe Haven Demand** for Dollar: - Gold prices fell on Tuesday as the safe haven demand for the dollar was boosted by concerns over the pending trade dispute between the U.S. and China. A stronger greenback makes the dollar-denominated metal more expensive for holders of foreign currencies.
 - Oil Prices Slide Extending Sharp October Decline: - Oil prices continued to slide on Tuesday, adding to a sharp decline for the month of October as concerns over the outlook for global demand amid simmering trade tensions, coupled with increasing supply and rising inventories, pummeled the outlook for crude.
 - Natural Gas Prediction Prices Rebound on Low Inventories: -Natural gas prices moved higher on Tuesday pushing back above resistance near the 20-day moving average at 3.22. Support is seen near the 50-day moving average at 3.03.

Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
