- **Eicher Motors** October auto sales: Royal Enfield sales up 1 percent at 70,451 units versus 69,492 units; exports fall 72 percent to 407 units versus 1,478 units YoY.
- HeroMotoCorp October auto sales: Total sales rise to 7.3 lakh units versus 6.3 lakh units YoY.
- TCS: Company acquired W12 Studios, an award-winning digital design studio based in London
- **Coal India**: DIPAM Secretary said offer for sale issue of 3 percent equity yielded Rs 5,266 crore to government.
- **Inox Leisure**: Board approved the issuance of maximum of 64 lakh equity shares to its promoter, Gujarat Fluorochemicals on a preferential issue basis at a price not less than the floor price i.e. Rs 241.71.
- **Aarti Industries**: Board approved raising of funds of Rs 750 crore by way of issue of equity shares or any other instruments or security.

MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex fell 10.08 points or 0.03% to settle at 34,431.97. The index hit high of 34,679.93 and low of 34,303.38 in intraday trade.

The Nifty 50 index fell 6.15 points or 0.06% to settle at 10,380.45. The index hit high of 10,441.90 and low of 10,341.90 in intraday trade.

Broader market settled on a strong note. Among secondary barometers, the BSE Mid-Cap index rose 1.10%. The BSE Small-Cap index rose 1.09%.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was strong. On BSE, 1613 shares rose and 988 shares fell. A total of 128 shares were unchanged.

 - > U.S. Stocks Rise on Earnings, Softer Trade Stance: Markets Wrap: - U.S. stocks rose for a third day as investors greeted the latest batch of earnings optimistically amid signs that the Trump administration will ease its trade war with China. The dollar fell the most since July.
 - Forex Dollar Extends Losses as **Pound Rally Continues**: - The dollar extended losses against a currency basket on Thursday as a rally in the pound continued on the back of hopes that the UK and the European Union are making progress in Brexit talks.
 - Oil Prices Sink to 2-Month Lows Amid U.S. Supply Surge: - Oil prices fell to their lowest level in more than two months on Thursday, as indications of swelling U.S. crude stockpiles weighed. U.S. oil inventories rose by a more-than-expected 3.2 million barrels last week, the U.S. Energy Information Administration said on Wednesday. It was the sixth straight weekly climb that has seen domestic supplies swell by a total of 31.9 million barrels over that period.
 - **▶** Gold Prices Rebound from 3-Week Lows as Dollar Drops: - Gold prices rebounded on Thursday from the almost three week lows reached in the previous session as the dollar weakened broadly. Gold prices settled at \$1,212.30 on Wednesday, which was the lowest close since October 11. The yellow metal ended October with a gain of 1.75%, which was the largest monthly gain since July 2017. A weaker dollar can make dollar denominated assets, like gold, less expensive to potential buyers holding other currencies.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

This Trading algorithm is designed basically for jobbing:

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
