MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex fell 60.73 points or 0.17% to settle at 34,950.92. The index rose 111.76 points, or 0.32% at the day's high of 35,123.41. The index fell 200.05 points, or 0.57% at the day's low of 34,811.60.

The Nifty 50 index fell 24.80 points or 0.24% to settle at 10,528.20. The index rose 5.80 points, or 0.05% at the day's high of 10,558.80. The index fell 76 points, or 0.72% at the day's low of 10,477.

Domestic stocks drifted lower in early trade on negative Asian stocks. Key benchmark indices cut losses in morning trade. Fresh selling dragged the key benchmark indices to intraday low in mid-morning trade. Indices were off day's low in early afternoon trade. Stocks hovered in narrow range with small losses in afternoon trade. Markets hovered in small range with negative bias in mid-afternoon trade. Indices cut losses in late trade.

The S&P BSE Mid-Capindex fell 0.47%. The S&P BSE Small-Capindex fell 0.28%.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was negative. On the BSE, 1290 shares rose and 1308 shares fell. A total of 194 shares were unchanged. Niftylikely to trade in the range of 10400-10650

 - Stocks Struggle Before U.S. Midterms; Dollar Rises: Markets Wrap: U.S. equity futures fluctuated and European stocks struggled to hold gains as investors looked ahead to the American elections this week, with a trade deal between the world's biggest economies seemingly off the table for now. Treasuries edged higher and the dollar climbed, while the pound strengthened on hopes of a Brexit breakthrough.
 - Dollar rally fades before U.S. elections; pound jumps: The dollar paused after three consecutive weeks of gains as investors took profits before U.S. midterm elections this week that may fuel a bout of volatility for global markets, with the British pound leading gains on Brexit deal breakthrough hopes.
 - ➤ Natural Gas Futures Surge 8% on Forecasts for More Heating Demand: Natural gas futures surged to their highest level in almost two years on Monday, as traders reacted to bullish weather forecasts for most parts of the United States over the next two weeks. Weather systems will track across the northern U.S. the next several days with rain and snow, leading to an increase in heating demand. Natural gas prices typically rise ahead of the winter as colder weather sparks indoor-heating demand. The heating season from November through March is the peak demand period for U.S. gas consumption.
 - Oil steady as U.S. sanctions on Iran begin, Tehran defiant: - Oil prices steadied on Monday as U.S. sanctions against Iran's fuel exports began but were softened by waivers allowing major buyers to import Iranian crude for a while, as Tehran said it would defy Washington and continue to sell.


Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
