- Escorts Group increased its stake in Optunia Power Infrastructure from 49 percent to 99 percent, by a cquiring 2.94 crore shares at face value of Rs 10 per share.
- JSW Steel said it would infuse Rs 63.5 crores in Vardhaman Industries to pay the creditors as per the Resolution Plan by
 NCLT. The entire shareholding of Vardhaman Industries will be reduced by way of capital reduction and it will be delisted.

MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex fell 52.66 points or 0.14% to settle at 36,431.67. The index fell 8.81 points, or 0.02% at the day's high of 36,475.52. The index fell 281.43 points, or 0.77% at the day's low of 36,202.90.

The Nifty 50 index fell 15.60 points or 0.14% to settle at 10,951.70. The index fell 4.75 points, or 0.04% at the day's high of 10,962.55. The index fell 87.25 points, or 0.80% at the day's low of 10,880.05.

The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.07%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index rose 0.12%.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was negative. On the BSE, 1226 shares rose and 1356 shares fell. A total of 166 shares were unchanged.

 - U.S. Stocks Fluctuate After Fed Day; Oil Drops: Markets Wrap: - U.S. equities fluctuated Thursday as markets digested the Federal Reserve's decision a day earlier. European and Asian shares also fell, the dollar slumped against most peers and the yen rallied. Crude tumbled about 3 percent in New York.
 - > Dollar slips toward a 10-day low on **growth concerns**: - The dollar fell toward a 10-day low on Thursday against its rivals as concerns grew the United States may be heading for a sharp economic slowdown next year despite the Federal Reserve raising interest rates for the fourth time in a year. Although U.S. policymakers have said they may raise interest rates three times by early 2020, the U.S. bond yield curve -- a widely considered indicator of future recessions -- flattened to 10 basis points and just a shade above a 11-year low set earlier this month.
 - Brent Crude Falls Below \$55 as Fed Hike Heightens Demand Fears: - Oil briefly fell below \$55 a barrel in London for the first time in over a year as a U.S. Federal Reserve interest-rate hike stoked demand fears just as markets contend with excess supply. Brent futures slid as much as 4.5 percent to the lowest since September 2017.
 - Gold climbs as dovish Fed spooks **investors**: - Gold prices have risen sharply in the Thursday session. In the North American session, the spot price for one ounce of gold is \$1260.68, up 1.40% on the day. On the release front, U.S. unemployment claims rose to 214 thousand, just under the forecast of 216 thousand.


Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
