#### **TOP STORY**

- **Praj Industries** expanded its bio-energy basket by adding compressed bio-gas technology in its portfolio. The company says it is on track with execution of three bio-refinery projects based on proprietary 2G technology.
- Lemon Tree Hotels signed a licensing agreement for 50-room resort property in Andhra Pradesh.
- **Shriram EPC** clarified on the news that PNB-led consortium has taken possession of its arm, stating that company has just 1.04 percent stake in the shareholding of the mentioned joint venture.
- **Shakti Pumps** said that there was a dispute between their Labour contractor and some workers resulting in the contractor to cancel the agreement. This led to the company shutting its operations between Jan. 9-10.
- KNR Constructions arm received financial closure from NHAI for Telangana Project worth Rs 12,340 crore.
- NBCC India secured total business worth Rs 188 crore for December.
- **Mukand** received no adverse letter from the exchanges for the proposed merger of its three arms with self, as to enable the company to file the scheme with NCLT.
- Welspun Enterprises arm executed an agreement with Maharashtra Public Works Department to upgrade roads in the state at a bid project cost of Rs 1,460 crore and for the first year's operation and maintenance cost for Rs 31.5 crore.
- ICICI Securities loses its spot to Zerodha as India's <u>largest broker</u>.

#### **MARKET COMMENTARY**

The Sensex, fell 106.41 points or 0.29% to settle at 36,106.50. The index hit high of 36,269.31 and low of 36,070.76 in intraday trade.

The Nifty 50 index fell 33.55 points or 0.31% to settle at 10,821.60. The index hit high of 10,859.35 and low of 10,801.80 in intraday trade.

Among secondary barometers, the BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.49%. The BSE Small-Cap index rose 0.19%.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was negative. On BSE, 1227 shares rose and 1373 shares fell. A total of 154 shares were unchanged.

  - ▶ U.S. Stocks Tumble as Outlook for Retailers Sours: Markets Wrap: -U.S. stocks fell as retailers plunged on expectations of a sales slowdown in 2019 and investors weighed the consequences of political tensions in America with the partial government shutdown continuing and the possibility of the China trade dispute easing. West Texas crude slipped below \$52 a barrel after Wednesday's 5 percent increase, putting it on pace for its first drop in two weeks.
  - ➤ Forex U.S. Dollar Rises but Still Under Pressure After Fed Minutes: The greenback was slightly higher on Thursday after dovish minutes from the Federal Reserve in the previous session caused a steep decline in the dollar.
    Minutes from the Fed's December meeting showed that many policymakers are in favor of rates staying steady this year, increasing expectations that there will be no hikes in 2019. The dovish tone drove the dollar down to an almost three-month low of 94.63.
  - ➤ Oil Falls as U.S-China Trade Hope Fades: - Crude prices were lower on Thursday, giving back earlier gains as optimism over U.S.-China trade talks wore off.
  - ➢ Gold Prices Hold Steady Ahead of Fed's Powell: - Gold prices held steady around the unchanged mark on Thursday as investors awaited remarks from Federal Reserve chair Jerome Powell amid expectations that the head of the central bank will reaffirm a pause in policy tightening.

# **Arbitrage**

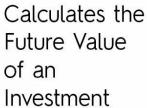
Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
