- MPS approved investment of Rs 40 crore in its wholly owned arm MPS Interactive Systems.
- IDFC First Bank: The Reserve Bank of India approved V Vaidyanathan as managing director, chief executive officer of the bank for three years with effect from Dec. 19 2018.
- Hari Mundra resigned as the non-executive director of **Ceat** with effect from Jan. 29.
- **Vodafone Idea**'s board to meet on Jan. 23 to consider fund raising. The company had earlier formed a committee to evaluate fund raising of up to Rs 25,000 crore via equity. The fund raising is expected to complete before March 2019.
- **Reliance Infrastructure**'s subsidiary Delhi Airport Metro Express Private Limited (DAMEPL) to move to Supreme Court against the arbitration award in the matter of Delhi Metro Rail Corporation (DMRC).
- ITI signed a purchase order contract with Gujarat Fibre Grid Network Ltd. (GFGNL), worth Rs 1,011.41 crore to be completed in one year, for implementing BharatNet Phase II project in Gujarat. Of the total order, Rs 190 crore is towards operation and maintenance for three years.
- SBI: Hitachi has accepted to acquire 26 percent equity in SBI Payment Services Private Limited.
- JSW Steel and the U.S.-based diversified Harsco Corporation entered into a 10-year agreement to provide a range of mill services. Under the contract, Harsco will provide on site slag handling services to JSW plant in Maharashtra's Dovili.

#### **MARKET COMMENTARY**

The Sensex, rose 12.53 points or 0.03% to settle at 36,386.61. The index hit high of 36,469.98 and low of 36,218.33 in intraday trade.

The Nifty 50 index rose 1.75 points or 0.02% to settle at 10,906.95. The index hit high of 10,928.20 and low of 10,852.20 in intraday trade.

The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index fell 0.79%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index fell 0.73%.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was weak. On the BSE, 896 shares rose and 1650 shares fell. A total of 165 shares were unchanged.

  - Stocks Advance; Treasuries Fall, Greenback Rises: Markets Wrap: -U.S. stocks rose for a fourth day as more signs of strength in economy buoyed investor confidence heading into the heart of earnings season. Treasuries fell and the dollar gained.
  - Forex U.S. Dollar Rises as Consumer Optimism Falls: - The greenback picked up steam on Friday despite U.S. consumer optimism hitting its lowest level since Donald Trump was elected president and the government shutdown moving into its 28th day. The dollar was supported by a strongerthan-expected report for U.S. industrial production in December, in which manufacturing posted an impressive 1.1% gain from November. Such positive surprises relieve some of the worries about the strength of the economy after the slowdown at the end of last year.
  - > Oil Prices Jump as IEA Highlights **OPEC Cuts**: - Crude prices jumped on Friday after a report from the International Energy Agency pointed to recent output cuts from OPEC, but also said output from the U.S. will be a major factor this year.
  - > Gold Prices Slip on U.S.-China Trade **Hopes:** - Gold prices traded slightly lower on Friday in Asia after a report that the U.S. is considering easing tariffs on Chinese products improved sentiment toward risk assets and hit demand for safe havens. Increasing hopes that a 'hard Brexit' scenario can be avoided was also cited as a headwind for the precious metal.

## SBS - Jobbing

SBS Stands for Simple Buying and Selling

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

This Trading algorithm is designed basically for jobbing:

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



## **Arbitrage**

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
