The Sensex, rose 86.63 points or 0.24% to settle at 36,195.10. The index hit high of 36,258.28 and low of 35,996.68 in intraday trade.

The Nifty 50 index rose 18.30 points or 0.17% to settle at 10,849.80. The index hit high of 10,866.60 and low of 10,798.65 in intraday trade.

Among secondary barometers, the BSE Mid-Cap index fell 0.15%. The BSE Small-Cap index fell 0.59%.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was weak. On BSE, 952 shares rose and 1547 shares fell. A total of 155 shares were unchanged.

# **Arbitrage**


Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
