The Sensex surged 665.44 points or 1.87% to settle at 36,256.69, its highest closing level since 22 January 2019. The index rose 686.88 points, or 1.93% at the day's high of 36,278.13. The index rose 148.82 points, or 0.42% at the day's low of 35740.07.

The Nifty 50 index advanced 179.15 points or 1.68% to settle at 10,830.95, its highest closing level since 24 January 2019. The index rose 186.25 points, or 1.75% at the day's high of 10,838.05. The index rose 26.75 points, or 0.25% at the day's low of 10678.55.

 - > U.S. Stocks Extend Their Best Month in Three Years: Markets Wrap: - U.S. stocks climbed, extending the biggest monthly rally in more than three years, as better-than-expected corporate earnings and the Federal Reserve's dovish turn lifted investor sentiment.
 - Trump upbeat on China trade talks but wants to meet Xi to cinch deal: -U.S. President Donald Trump expressed optimism on Thursday about high-level trade talks with Chinese officials in Washington but said no final deal would be made until he meets with Chinese President Xi Jinping in the near future.
 - Forex U.S. Dollar Inches Up as Fed Decision, Trade, Weigh: - The dollar made some gains on Thursday, after falling to near a three-week low Wednesday as the Federal Reserve put further monetary policy tightening on ice. The Fed left interest rates on hold at its meeting on Wednesday, citing uncertainty over the global economic outlook. It also softened its stance on reducing the size of its balance sheet.
 - > OPEC oil output drops on Saudi cut, outages and sanctions: - OPEC oil supply has fallen in January by the largest amount in two years, a Reuters survey found, as Saudi Arabia and its Gulf allies over-delivered on the group's supply-cutting pact while Iran, Libya and Venezuela registered involuntary declines.
 - Natural Gas prices slide after weekly EIA report shows a smaller-thanexpected weekly fall in supply: -The U.S. Energy Information Administration reported Thursday that domestic supplies of natural gas fell by 173 billion cubic feet for the week ended Jan. 25. 
Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
