- **Vedanta**: Board approved 2nd interim dividend of Rs 1.85 per share i.e. 185 percent on face value of Re 1 for the financial year 2018-19.
- Varroc Engineering: Step down subsidiary Varroc Lighting Systems, Poland opened new Research & Development Centre.
- Asian Granito India: Board approved the issue of 50 lakh convertible warrants at a price of Rs 180 per convertible
 warrants to promoter, promoter group and non-promoters. Board also approved the overall limit of Rs 300 crore for
 related party transaction with subsidiary company Crystal Ceramic Industries Private Limited.
- **Biocon**: USFDA concluded a pre-approval inspection of company's insulin drug substance manufacturing facility triggered by a New Drug Application submitted by insulin AP/customer. The inspection at the Bengaluru facility took place between February 25-March 5, resulting in a Form 483 with six observations.
- MEP Infrastructure Developers: Promoter released a pledge on 38 lakh shares (representing 2.07 percent of total paidup equity).
- Jayant Agro-Organics: Promoter Jayant Finvest increases stake in company by 3.22 percent to 58.93 percent.
- Ajmera Realty & Infra India: Promoter ARIIL Trust raises stake in company by 2.78 percent to 52.81 percent.
- Leel Electricals: Bharat Raj Punj, Managing Director of the company has tendered his resignation due to his personal and professional reasons.

MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex, rose 193.56 points or 0.53% to settle at 36,636.10. The index hit high of 36,666.47 and low of 36,456.82 in intraday trade.

The Nifty 50 index rose 65.55 points or 0.60% to settle at 11,053. The index hit high of 11,062.30 and low of 10,998.85 in intraday trade.

After opening higher, indices pared gains in morning trade. Benchmarks firmed up once again in mid-morning trade and were trading near the day's high in early afternoon trade. Indices turned range bound at higher levels in afternoon trade. Barometers hit fresh intraday high in late trade.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was strong. On BSE, 1673 shares rose and 1026 shares fell. A total of 151 shares were unchanged.

 - > U.S. Crude Oil Inventories Rose by 7.07M Barrels Last Week: EIA: - U.S. crude oil inventories rose more than expected last week, the Energy Information Administration said in its weekly report on Wednesday. The EIA data showed that crude oil inventories rose by 7.07 million barrels in the week to March 1. That was compared to forecasts for a stockpile build of 1.20 million barrels, after a decline of 8.65 million barrels in the previous week. The EIA report also showed that gasoline inventories fell by 4.23 million barrels, compared to expectations for a draw of 2.08 million barrels, while distillate stockpiles decreased by 2.39 million barrels, compared to forecasts for a decline of 1.44 million.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

This Trading algorithm is designed basically for jobbing:

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
