MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex fell 135.36 points or 0.34% to settle at 39,140.28. The index rose 211.81 points, or 0.54% at the day's high of 39,487.45. The index fell 192.48 points, or 0.49% at the day's low of 39,083.16.

The Nifty 50 index fell 34.35 points or 0.29% to settle at 11,752.80. The index rose 69 points, or 0.59% at the day's high of 11,856.15. The index fell 48.65 points, or 0.41% at the day's low of 11,738.50.

Selling was broad based. Among secondary barometers, the BSE Mid-Cap index fell 0.89%. The BSE Small-Cap index fell 0.99%.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was weak. On BSE, 886 shares rose and 1674 shares fell. A total of 167 shares were unchanged.

 - Wall Street opens higher after encouraging China data, earnings: -U.S. stocks opened higher on Wednesday, as upbeat economic data from China and a jump in Qualcomm shares sparked gains in chipmakers, with sentiment also lifted by largely positive earnings reports.
 - Thin Trade: The greenback was flat on Wednesday in holiday-thinned trade as another round of upbeat earnings continued to push investors towards equities and other riskier assets. Trading is expected to be thin for the rest of the week, as U.S. markets close on Friday for the Easter holiday. Earlier data in China had helped lift the dollar, as gross domestic product grew 6.4% in the first quarter from a year earlier, suggesting the economy is not slowing down like initially feared.

 - ▶ U.S. Crude Oil Inventories Fell by 1.4M Barrels Last Week: EIA: - U.S. crude oil inventories fell last week, breaking a stretch of three consecutive builds, according to official government data released on Wednesday. That was compared to forecasts for a stockpile draw of 1.2 million barrels, after a gain of 7.03 million barrels in the previous week. The EIA report also showed however that gasoline inventories declined by 1.17 million barrels, compared to expectations for a draw of 2.13 million barrels.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

This Trading algorithm is designed basically for jobbing:

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage

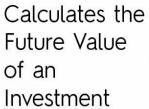
Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
