MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex fell 80.30 points or 0.21% to settle at 38,564.88. The index rose 187.43 points, or 0.49% at the day's high of 38,832.61. The index fell 126.92 points, or 0.33% at the day's low of 38,518.26.

The Nifty 50 index fell 18.50 points or 0.16% to settle at 11,575.95. The index rose 51.50 points, or 0.44% at the day's high of 11,645.95. The index fell 29.65 points, or 0.26% at the day's low of 11,564.80.

The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.03%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index fell 0.13%.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was negative. On the BSE, 1125 shares rose and 1403 shares fell. A total of 152 shares were unchanged.

 - ➤ U.S. Stocks Advance on Earnings as Dollar Rallies: Markets Wrap: U.S. equities climbed on the back of better-than-forecast earnings, while the dollar strengthened and Treasury yields dipped.
 - FOREX-Dollar gains with FX volatility holding near five-year lows: - The dollar held near three-week highs on Tuesday as a drop in market volatility ramped up demand for riskier assets, with higher U.S. bond yields also offering some support.
 - Gold Prices Fall as Earnings Boost Risk Sentiment: - Gold prices lost ground on Tuesday as a wave of betterthan-expected earnings stateside supported risk sentiment and investors opted for equities.
 - > Oil hits highest since November as **U.S. tightens Iran sanctions:** - Oil prices hit their highest since November on Tuesday after Washington announced the end of all waivers on imports of sanctions-hit Iranian crude, pressuring importers to stop buying from Tehran. Despite Washington's announcement, spare capacity from other suppliers such as Saudi Arabia and possible continued imports of Iranian crude by China could balance the market. The United States on Monday demanded that buyers of Iranian oil stop purchases by May 1 or face sanctions, ending six months of waivers which allowed Iran's eight biggest buyers, most of them in Asia, to continue importing limited volumes. Iran was the fourth-largest producer among the Organization of the Petroleum Exporting Countries at around 3 million barrels per day (bpd), but April exports have shrunk to below 1 million bpd, according to tanker data.

Arbitrage

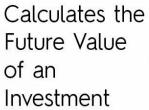
Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
