MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex fell 230.22 points or 0.61% to settle at 37,558.91, its lowest closing level since 12 March 2019. The index fell 8.67 points, or 0.02% at the day's high of 37,780.46. The index fell 383.73 points, or 1.02% at the day's low of 37,405.40.

The Nifty 50 index fell 57.65 points or 0.51% to settle at 11,301.80, its lowest closing level since 12 March 2019. The index fell 1.85 points, or 0.02% at the day's high of 11,357.60. The index fell 104.40 points, or 0.92% at the day's low of 11,255.05.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was negative. On the BSE, 1065 shares rose and 1404 shares fell. A total of 154 shares were unchanged.

 Hopes Evaporate: Wall Street traded
 sharply lower on Thursday with the S&P
 500 and Nasdaq racking up a fourth day
 of declines, as hopes that the U.S. and
 China could avoid escalating their trade
 dispute evaporated.
 - Yen surges to three-month high on fears of U.S. tariffs: The Japanese yen surged to a 3-month high against the dollar on Thursday as investors piled into the safe-haven currency fearing that the U.S.-China trade conflict could escalate. Two days of trade talks begin in Washington on Thursday and traders are waiting to see whether Chinese and U.S. negotiators can salvage a deal to prevent more U.S. tariff increases.
 - Oil Prices Steady as Lower OPEC Output Outweighs Trade Tension: -Oil prices held steady on Thursday as reports that OPEC is keeping supply tight outweighed risk-off sentiment stemming from Sino-U.S. trade uncertainty. The survey found that production levels among members varied, with Saudi Arabia producing at a 15-month low, while Iran's output fell to levels that were even lower than at previous times when it was under U.S. sanctions.
 - ➢ Gold rises as global markets retreat ahead of looming U.S.-China trade deadline: - Gold futures headed higher Thursday as investors braced for an intensifying Sino-U.S. trade conflict, which could provide a lift to bullion amid markets stricken by international trade fears.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
