MARKET COMMENTARY

The barometer index, the S&P BSE Sensex, surged 1,421.90 points or 3.75% at 39,352.67, a record closing high. The index hit high of 39,412.56 and low of 38,570.04 in intraday trade.

The Nifty 50 index surged 421.10 points or 3.69% at 11,828.25, a record closing high. The index hit high of 11,845.20 and low of 11,591.70 in intraday trade. The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 3.57%.

The S&P BSE Small-Cap index rose 3.55%.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was strong. On the BSE, 2019 shares rose and 609 shares fell. A total of 185 shares were unchanged.

 - Wall St. drops as tech stocks tumble on Huawei fallout fears: - U.S. stocks fell on Monday, as a crackdown on China's Huawei Technologies raised concerns of a bigger impact on chipmakers and added to fears of an escalation in trade war between the two nations.
 - U.S. Dollar Flat Amid Trade Tensions: - The U.S. dollar was flat on Monday following increased trade tensions after the White House blacklisted Chinese giant Huawei.
 - ➢ Gold claws up from 2-week low as dollar, stocks slip: Gold prices inched up Monday after settling at a two-week low in the previous session, with both the dollar and stocks retreating. Gold futures logged a weekly loss of 0.9% last week on the back of a jump in U.S. consumer sentiment and a slightly firmer buck. The gold-backed SPDR Gold Shares exchange-traded fund GLD, 0.15% tipped lower, looking to extend Friday's loss after trading 0.8% lower for last week.
 - Oil Prices Fall as Russia Casts Doubt On Extending Output Cuts: - Crude prices were volatile on Monday as uncertainty over whether Russia would agree to extend production cuts jostled with fears of conflict in the Middle East all against the backdrop of a worsening trade dispute between the world's two biggest oil consumers. Prices were supported by a consensus at a weekend meeting in Jeddah, Saudi Arabia, that OPEC, Russia and other exporters would need to keep some sort of output restraint in place after their current deal expires at the end of June.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
