- Hero Motocorp: Total sales in June 2019 declined to 6,16,526 units against 6,52,028 units sold in June 2018.
- <u>DHFL</u>: Lenders decide to sign inter-creditor agreement to implement resolution plan by July 5. Company is in SMA-0 category for a few banks and delayed payment to few lenders on bank loans in June CNBC-TV18 sources.
- HCL Technologies: Acquisition of select IBM Software Products has been completed.
- JSW Energy: Company's deal to buy 1000 MW thermal power plant in Chhattisgarh from JSPL terminated.
- Cox & Kings: Company defaulted on Rs 50 crore payment.
- GAIL India: Fitch affirmed company's foreign issuer rating at BBB- with stable outlook.
- MOIL: Company hiked manganese ore prices on silico grades by 5 percent..
- **SBI**: Bank and NIIF signed MoU to boost capital availability for infra projects.
- <u>ICRA</u>: Company placed Naresh Takkar on leave, effective immediately, until further notice, and decided to appoint Vipul Agarwal as interim chief operating officer.
- <u>Tata Motors</u>: Commercial and passenger vehicle sales in domestic market down 14 percent to 49,073 units versus 56,773 units YoY.
- TVS Motor Company: Two-wheeler sales fell to 2,83,461 units versus 3,01,201 units YoY.

MARKET COMMENTARY

The barometer index, the S&P BSE Sensex, rose 291.86 points or 0.74% to 39,686.50. The index hit a high of 39,764.82 and a low of 39,541.09 in intraday.

The Nifty 50 index rose 76.75 points or 0.65% to 11,865.60. The index hit a high of 11,884.65 and a low of 11,830.80 in intraday.

The broader market underperformed the benchmark index. The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index was up 0.54%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index was up 0.30%.

The market breadth, indicating the overall health of the market, was negative. On the BSE, 1268 shares rose and 1307 shares fell. A total of 169 shares were unchanged.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
