#### **MARKET COMMENTARY**

The barometer index, the S&P BSE Sensex, rose 68.81 points or 0.17% to 39,917.65. The index hit a high of 39,979.10 and a low of 39,858.33 in intraday.

The Nifty 50 index rose 30 points or 0.25% to 11,946.75. The index hit a high of 11,969.25 and a low of 11,923.65 in intraday.

Positive global shares also supported gains. Global stocks edged higher after weaker-than-expected US economic data gave investors cause to anticipate that the Federal Reserve will cut interest rates at its upcoming July meeting.

In the broader market, the S&P BSE Mid-Cap index was down 0.19%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index was up 0.12%.

The market breadth was positive. On the BSE, 1245 shares rose and 1201 shares fell. A total of 173 shares were unchanged. Nifty likely to trade in the range of 11870-12000

  - Dollar Struggles as Fed Rate Cuts **Bets Weigh**: - The dollar was trading near one-week lows against the yen on Thursday as declines in U.S. Treasury yields boosted expectations the U.S. Federal Reserve will cut interest rates later this month. Government bonds are in the middle of a global rally, which has pushed U.S. Treasury yields to the lowest in over two-and-a-half years and sent European yields to record lows on increasing bets major central banks will cut interest rates to bolster the global economy. Waning expectations for a quick resolution to the U.S.-China trade war also hurt sentiment on the dollar.
  - ➢ Oil Prices Drop on Demand Worries; U.S.-China to Restart Talks: - Oil prices moved lower in early morning trade on Thursday as demand worries continued to exert downward pressure on the sector. Trading was expected to be thin due to the Fourth of July holiday in the U.S. Weekly data from the U.S. Energy Information Administration showed a much smaller than expected decline in U.S. crude inventories, casting doubt on demand despite it being in the middle of the U.S. driving season.
  - ▶ Gold Prices Dip as Focus Shifts to U.S. Jobs: Gold prices traded slightly lower in holiday-thinned trade on Thursday but remained supported by expectations for central bank easing ahead of the U.S. employment report. Markets took the news to mean that the way is cleared for both the Fed and the ECB to comply with expectations that the central banks will move forward with policy easing. Weaker-than-expected readings could cement expectations that the Fed will cut interest rates at its July 30-31 policy meeting.

# **Arbitrage**

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
