- <u>Infosys</u> Q1: Consolidated profit falls 6.8 percent to Rs 3,802 crore versus Rs 4,078 crore. Dollar revenue rises 2.3 percent to \$3,131 million versus \$3,060 million QoQ. Company raises FY20 constant currency growth guidance to 8.5-10 percent from 7.5-9.5 percent and maintains FY20 EBIT margin guidance at 21-23 percent.

MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex fell 86.88 points or 0.22% to settle at 38,736.23. The index rose 198.73 points, or 0.51% at the day's high of 39,021.84. The index fell 138.26 points, or 0.36% at the day's low of 38,684.85.

The Nifty 50 index fell 30.40 points or 0.26% to settle at 11,552.50. The index rose 56.65 points, or 0.49% at the day's high of 11,639.55. The index fell 44.30 points, or 0.38% at the day's low of 11,538.60.

The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.41%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index rose 0.16%. Both these indices outperformed the Sensex.

The market breadth was negative On the BSE, 1190 shares rose and 1254 shares fell. A total of 150 shares were unchanged.

> Dow Reaches Another Record High:

- The Dow reached another record high on Friday, after Federal Reserve Chairman Jerome Powell's dovish comments earlier in the week set stocks soaring in anticipation of a rate cut later this month.
- U.S. Dollar Remains Subdued After PPI Data: The U.S. dollar was flat on Friday as a slight uptick in core inflation failed to deter expectations that the Federal Reserve will cut rates at the end of July. Fed Chairman Jerome Powell testified before Congress this week, telling lawmakers that the central bank is concerned about weak inflation and other uncertainties. The Fed is expected to cut rates by 25 basis points at its next policy meeting at the end of the month. Meanwhile, core inflation data rose in June, pointing to a moderate gain in retail prices.
- Oil Prices on Track for Weekly Jump as Storm Barry Trumps Glut Concerns: - Oil prices were on track for a sharp weekly gain as concerns over Tropical Storm Barry hitting supply outweighed worries of a global supply glut in the making.
- ▶ Gold Prices Wobble as Wholesale Inflation Ticks Higher: Headline inflation at factory gates rose 1.7% from a year earlier in June, topping expectations for a larger drop to 1.6%, while the core annualized reading that removes volatile food and energy components unexpectedly held steady at 2.3%. The readings follow a similar picture painted Thursday by core consumer prices that also unexpectedly ticked higher in June.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
