MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex rose 160.48 points or 0.41% to settle at 38,896.71. The index rose 287.74 points, or 0.74% at the day's high of 39,023.97. The index fell 39.63 points, or 0.10% at the day's low of 38,696.60.

The Nifty 50 index rose 35.85 points or 0.31% to settle at 11,588.35. The index rose 65.90 points, or 0.57% at the day's high of 11,618.40. The index fell 20.20 points, or 0.17% at the day's low of 11,532.30.

The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index fell 0.61%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index fell 0.63%. Both these indices underperformed the Sensex.

The market breadth was tilted in favour of sellers. On the BSE, 864 shares rose and 1615 shares fell. A total of 154 shares were unchanged.

> Dow Reaches Another Record High:

- The Dow reached another record high on Friday, after Federal Reserve Chairman Jerome Powell's dovish comments earlier in the week set stocks soaring in anticipation of a rate cut later this month.
- ➤ U.S. Dollar Remains Subdued After PPI Data: The U.S. dollar was flat on Friday as a slight uptick in core inflation failed to deter expectations that the Federal Reserve will cut rates at the end of July. Fed Chairman Jerome Powell testified before Congress this week, telling lawmakers that the central bank is concerned about weak inflation and other uncertainties. The Fed is expected to cut rates by 25 basis points at its next policy meeting at the end of the month. Meanwhile, core inflation data rose in June, pointing to a moderate gain in retail prices.
- Oil Prices on Track for Weekly Jump as Storm Barry Trumps Glut Concerns: - Oil prices were on track for a sharp weekly gain as concerns over Tropical Storm Barry hitting supply outweighed worries of a global supply glut in the making.
- ➢ Gold Prices Wobble as Wholesale Inflation Ticks Higher: Headline inflation at factory gates rose 1.7% from a year earlier in June, topping expectations for a larger drop to 1.6%, while the core annualized reading that removes volatile food and energy components unexpectedly held steady at 2.3%. The readings follow a similar picture painted Thursday by core consumer prices that also unexpectedly ticked higher in June.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

Pre Defined Stop Loss

Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
