MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex fell 16.67 points or 0.04% to settle at 37,830.98, its lowest closing level since 16 May 2019. The index rose 322.22 points, or 0.85% at the day's high of 38,169.87. The index fell 72.14 points, or 0.19% at the day's low of 37,775.51.

The Nifty 50 index fell 19.15 points or 0.17% to settle at 11,252.15, its lowest closing level since 15 May 2019. The index rose 90.10 points, or 0.80% at the day's high of 11,361.40. The index fell 31.95 points, or 0.28% at the day's low of 11,239.35.

The Nifty 50 index has fallen 435.35 points, or 3.72%, in six sessions from its recent closing high of 11,687.50 on 17 July 2019. The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.53%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index fell 0.09%. The market breadth was tilted in favour of sellers. On the BSE, 1082 shares rose and 1353 shares fell. A total of 168 shares were unchanged.

 - Wall Street falls after mixed earnings; ECB chief disappoints: - U.S. stocks fell on Thursday after a handful of mixed earnings reports pointed to a slowing global economy, and as the European Central Bank chief's comments on monetary policy failed to impress investors.
 - ➤ U.S. Dollar Slumps as Euro Rebounds After Draghi Comments: - The U.S. dollar fell on Thursday after durable goods orders in May were revised lower, while the euro was higher after comments from European Central Bank President Mario Draghi pointed to more stimulus measures.
 - ➤ ECB Signals Package of Easing Measures in September: - The European Central Bank opened the door to interest rate cuts and a raft of further measures to ease monetary policy in September, in a desperate attempt to support a Eurozone economy squeezed increasingly hard by the U.S.'s trade war with China and by a looming "hard" Brexit.
 - Oil Prices Bounce Higher as Tug of War Between Bulls and Bears Plays Out: - Oil bounced back on Thursday, recovering most of the prior day's decline, as traders weighed opposing price signals but analysts warned that concerns over demand for oil would prevail over other bullish factors such as Middle East tensions.
 - Gold Prices Pare Gains After Durable Goods, Jobless Claims Beat Expectations: - Gold prices pared gains after better-than-expected U.S. economic data dented expectations for more aggressive policy easing from the Federal Reserve.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

This Trading algorithm is designed basically for jobbing:

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
