- <u>Coffee Day Enterprises</u>: Board postponed company's April-June quarter earnings. It was scheduled to report earnings on August 8. In addition, Sulakshana Raghavan resigned as independent director for personal reasons.
- <u>Adani Green Energy</u>: Step down subsidiary Adani Renewable Energy has part commissioned 100 MWac capacity in Rajasthan out of 200 MWac solar power project.
- **Spice Mobility**: Subsidiary Spice VAS (Africa) Pte. Limited executed a share purchase agreement whereby SVA has agreed to transfer 100 percent stake in its wholly owned subsidiary, SVA (Mauritius) Private Limited to Karma Trust Group. Consequently, SVAM will cease to be a subsidiary of SVA and step down subsidiary of the company.
- Rollatainers: Darshan Prasad Yadav has resigned from the position of Chief Financial Officer.
- Filatex India: Board approved the proposal of raising of funds upto an amount of Rs 250 crore.
- Karnataka Bank: Lender ties up with FISDOM, a online platform for sale of mutual funds.
- <u>Reliance Industries</u>: Subsidiary Reliance Industrial Investments and Holdings entered into an agreement for acquisition of equity shares of Shopsense Retail Technologies Pvt. Ltd. (Shopsense or Fynd)

MARKET COMMENTARY

The Sensex rose 99.90 points or 0.27% to settle at 37,118.22. The index rose 356.84 points, or 0.96% at the day's high of 37,375.16. The index fell 410.91 points, or 1.11% at the day's low of 36,607.41.

The Nifty 50 index rose 17.35 points or 0.16% to settle at 10,997.35. The index rose 100.15 points, or 0.91% at the day's high of 11,080.15. The index fell 236.45 points, or 2.13% at the day's low of 10,848.95.

In broader market, the S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.15%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index fell 0.44%.

The market breadth was negative. On the BSE, 1097 shares rose and 1362 shares fell. A total of 138 shares were unchanged.

 - Wall St. drops at open on Trump's tariff threat, slow job growth: - Wall Street's main indexes sank to one-month lows on Friday after a sharp escalation in U.S.-China trade tensions and tepid job growth in July reinforced fears of a global economic slowdown.
 - ▶ U.S. Nonfarm Payrolls Rise 164,000, Unemployment Rate Holds Steady: - The U.S. economy created fewer jobs in July, while the unemployment rate held steady and annual wage inflation ticked higher, according to official government data released on Friday. Nonfarm payrolls (NFP) rose by 164,000 in July, in line with consensus expectations. The jobless rate was unchanged at 3.7%, also in line with forecasts. Wage inflation grew 3.2% on an annualized basis. Consensus had expected no change to the prior month's 3.1% rise.
 - Dollar Down Vs Havens, up vs High-Yielders on Tariff News: - The dollar fell against safe havens such as the yen and Swiss franc in early trading in Europe Friday, but was higher against most other currencies after President Donald Trump announced a sharp escalation of the U.S.'s trade war with China.
 - Oil Prices Bounce After Tariff Threats Cause Worst Slide in 3 Years: - Oil prices rebounded on Friday after its worst selloff in three years. U.S. President Donald Trump's pledge to place a 10% tariff on a further \$300 billion in Chinese goods sent crude tumbling 7% a day earlier.
 - Gold ETFs poised for upside with more Rate Cuts: - Gold ETFs are steady, preparing for a drive to the upside amid increased expectations of further U.S. interest rate cuts.

SBS - Jobbing

SBS Stands for Simple Buying and Selling

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

This Trading algorithm is designed basically for jobbing:

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
