MARKET COMMENTARY

The Nifty opened below 10,700 for the first time since 20 February 2019. It quickly regained that level and advanced further. After facing some stiff resistance, the Nifty breached 10,800 level to hit a fresh intraday high in mid afternoon trade. Despite some profit selling in the final hour, the index managed to close above 10,800 mark.

The 30-share BSE Sensex rose 228.23 points or 0.63% to 36,701.16. The Nifty 50 index rose 88 points or 0.82% to 10,829.35.

Recovery was broad based with gainers outpacing losers. On the BSE, 1322 shares rose and 1128 shares fell. A total of 134 shares were unchanged. The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.93%. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index rose 0.55%.

 - China's tariff blows weighs on Wall Street, Powell speech in focus: - U.S. stocks fell on Friday after China threatened to impose additional tariffs on \$75 billion worth of U.S. goods, ahead of a highly anticipated speech from Federal Reserve Chair Jerome Powell.
 - > U.S. Dollar Flat as Powell Promises to 'Sustain' Economic Expansion: -The U.S. dollar was flat on Friday after Federal Reserve Chairman Jerome Powell said the central bank would keep an eye on the economy and act as needed, but failed to give any new guidance on interest rates. China's latest tariffs, which follow U.S. duties on \$300 billion worth of Chinese goods, threaten to prolong an ongoing trade war between the world's top two economies that has raised concerns about slowing global growth. China's commerce ministry said it would impose additional tariffs on thousands of U.S. products, including agricultural products, crude oil, small aircraft and cars. Tariffs on some products would take effect on Sept. 1 and others on Dec. 15.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
