MARKET COMMENTARY

MARKET LEVELS

The barometer index, the S&P BSE Sensex, fell 261.68 points or 0.70% to 37,123.31. The Nifty 50 index fell 72.40 points or 0.65% to 11,003.50.

The 50-unit Nifty opened below 11,000 mark and hit an intraday low of 10,968 in afternoon trade. Later the index trimmed losses and flirted with 11,000 mark and closed a tad above that level.

The market breadth was positive. On the BSE, 1369 shares rose and 1150 shares fell. A total of 177 shares remain unchanged.

 - Wall Street Tumbles as Attack on Saudi Hits Oil Supply: - Wall Street fell after a weekend attack on Saudi Arabian oil installations crippled 5% of the world's oil supply, raising fears for the global economy and increasing the risk of war between the U.S. and Iran. Oil prices soared after the news, with the U.S. blaming Iran for the attacks. The Islamic Republic denies any involvement.
 - ➢ Japanese Yen Rises Amid Heightened Geopolitical Tensions in Middle East: -The Japanese yen rose against the U.S. dollar on Monday in Asia amid heightened geopolitical tensions in the Middle East after weekend attacks on Saudi oil plants disrupted global oil supplies.
 - Oil surges 20% after Saudi attack, softens on stockpile hopes: -Oil prices surged nearly 20% at one point on Monday, with Brent crude posting its biggest intraday gain since the Gulf War in 1991, after an attack on Saudi Arabian oil facilities at the weekend halved the kingdom's production. Prices came off their peaks after U.S. President Donald Trump authorized the use of his country's emergency stockpile to ensure stable supply.
 - Gold scores a pop from historic oil outage: Gold futures headed solidly higher on Monday after an attack on Saudi Arabian oil production sent oil prices skyrocketing and investors turning to haven assets, including bonds and precious metals. The gain for oil comes after Saudi oil production facilities on Saturday were hit by a drone attack according to Saudi Arabian officials, which knocked out 5.7 million barrels of daily production, representing some 5% of global production.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both

Arbitrage


Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
