MARKET COMMENTARY

The barometer index, the S&P BSE Sensex, fell 470.41 points or 1.29% to 36,093.47. The Nifty 50 index fell 135.85 points or 1.25% to 10,704.80.

The Nifty-50 index slipped below 10,800 level in morning trade and extended losses as the session progressed. The index slipped below 10,700 in afternoon trade. Bargain hunting in the final half hour of trade pushed the Nifty above 10,700 mark.

The market breadth favoured the sellers. On the BSE, 722 shares rose and 1790 shares fell. A total of 116 shares remain unchanged.

Broader market tumbled. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index fell 1.15%. The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index fell 1.48%.

 - U.S. Stocks Gain with Europe Shares as Dollar Dips: Markets Wrap: - Yen, franc jump after central bank decisions; Treasuries rise, Oil extends gains as Mideast tensions flare; pound steadies, U.S. equities advanced with European stocks as investors processed a slew of fresh monetary-policy decisions and favorable comments about trade talks.
 - Yen Rises against Dollar After BOJ Holds: - The yen rose from a sevenweek low against the U.S. dollar on Thursday after the Bank of Japan kept monetary policy on hold, in the wake of the Federal Reserve's overnight decision to cut rates.
 - Gold Prices Edge Lower as Fed Refuses to Join Race to the Bottom: - Gold prices edged lower on Thursday, still under pressure from a Federal Reserve meeting that suggested the U.S. is still far from joining the "race to the bottom" on interest rates that other central banks have embarked on in recent months. A strong dollar and rising bond yields are traditionally bad news for gold, which has no nominal return and which is priced in a currency that not everyone outside the U.S. has access to. As such, gold futures had fallen as low as \$1,492 a troy ounce after the Fed's meeting on Wednesday, but they recovered most of those losses Thursday as bargain-hunters bought the dip.
 - Oil Prices Climb amid Supply Risk Fears:

 Oil prices climbed on Thursday amid renewed concerns over risks to global supply in the wake of last weekend's attacks on Saudi Arabia's oil infrastructure.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage


Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
