- <u>DHFL:</u> Leading depository CDSL has frozen shareholding of the promoters of debt-ridden mortgage lender DHFL due to delay in announcement of the company's financial earnings, PTI reported.
- <u>Aurobindo Pharma:</u> USFDA concluded inspection of Unit 7 of the manufacturing facility with 7 observations.
- SJVN: The government shelved a proposal to sell the company's stake to NTPC for now.
- Tata Motors: JLR's July-September retail sales fall 0.7 percent to 1.28 lakh units YoY.
- <u>Titan:</u> Q2 jewellery retail sales grow 7 percent, but revenues as per financials declined 2 percent YoY substantially due to the adverse impact of the hedges matured during the quarter.
- TCS: Pandora partners with TCS for its digital transformation.
- <u>NMDC</u>: The company said it is considering raising funds through the debt market. The board of directors will meet on October 11 to consider this.
- <u>Talwalkars Healthclubs:</u> Company defaulted of Rs 2.38 crore towards interest and principal of Rs 25 crore of loan taken from Lakshmi Vilas Bank

The barometer index, the BSE Sensex, fell 141.33 points or 0.38% to 37,531.98. The Nifty 50 index fell 48.35 points or 0.43% to 11,126.40.

Domestic stock markets will remain closed on Tuesday, 8 October 2019, on account of Dussehra.

The market breadth was tilted in favour of sellers. On the BSE, 892 shares rose and 1629 shares fell. A total of 230 shares remain unchanged.

The broader market was under pressure. The S&P BSE Small-Cap index fell 0.24%. The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index fell 0.75%.

 War Continues: U.S. futures tumbled
 on Tuesday, as the prospects of any sort
 of detente between the U.S. and China
 this week faded, and the EU and U.K.
 lurched further toward a disorderly 'Hard
 Brexit'.
 - Pound Falls on Brexit Budget Report; Turkish Lira Recovers: - The British pound headed lower again in early trade on Tuesday after a warning that a Hard Brexit could deliver a 100billion pound blow to public finances. A report by the Institute for Fiscal Studies think-tank concluded that the budget deficit could rise to 4 percent of gross domestic product if the U.K. leaves the European Union without a transitional agreement, as Prime Minister Boris Johnson is currently threatening to do. There is little sign of the EU accepting the U.K.'s latest proposals on changes to the existing Withdrawal Agreement in time for a new agreement to be finalized at next week's summit.
 - Gold prices get a boost as China-U.S. trade-deal uncertainty grows: -Gold prices headed higher early Tuesday, as doubts about a near-term resolution between the world's largest economies hurt demand for assets perceived as risky and fed appetite for haven assets, including bullion.
 - Oil lower as traders await U.S.-China trade talks: - Oil futures gave up early gains to turn lower Tuesday as traders kept tabs on developments ahead of U.S.-China trade talks due later this week, which could shape expectations around demand for crude.


Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
