- **Mindtree**: Q2 consolidated profit jumps 45.6 percent to Rs 135 crore versus Rs 92.7 crore QoQ, revenue rises 4.4 percent to Rs 1,914.3 crore versus Rs 1,834.2 crore QoQ.
- **Nalco**: Acute coal shortage affects company's smelter plant operation.
- **Quess Corp**: Company acquired 49 percent stake Trimax Smart Infraprojects for a consideration of Rs 13 crore.
- **Zee Entertainment**: VTB Capital acquired rights to dispose 10.71 percent equity held by Essel Media in company on October 11.
- NCC Finance: Shareholders approve voluntary liquidation of company under IBC.
- **Edelweiss Financial**: Competition Commission of India approved Kora Master Fund LP's investment of up to 10 percent (\$75 million) in Edelweiss Securities.
- **Bajaj Consumer**: HDFC MF acquired 7.75 lakh shares (5.25 percent equity) in company via open market.
- Cox & Kings: Interest due on October 15 on NCD was not paid to debenture holders.
- Transformers and Rectifiers India: Company bagged orders worth Rs 158 crore.

MARKET COMMENTARY

The barometer index, the BSE Sensex, rose 92.90 points or 0.24% to 38,598.99. The Nifty 50 index rose 43.25 points or 0.38% to 11,471.55.

On the BSE, 1152 shares rose and 1317 shares fell. A total of 198 shares remain unchanged.

The broader market was mixed. The S&P BSE Mid-Cap index fell 0.14%, but the S&P BSE Smallcap index rose 0.21%.

The Sensex rose 1.9% while the Nifty gained 2.11% in past four trading sessions.

 - Gold Prices Pick up as Weak Sales Data Revive Rate Cut Hopes: - Gold prices found a bid at the lower end of their recent trading range on Wednesday, as weak retail sales data from the U.S. encouraged traders again to place bets on further interest rate cuts from the Federal Reserve, while Brexit talks between the EU and the U.K. failed to deliver a breakthrough that by now has been largely discounted. According to Investing.com's Fed Rate Monitor Tool, investors now see an 88% chance of a 25 basis point cut at the Fed's policy meeting at the end of the month.

SBS Stands for Simple Buying and Selling

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

This Trading algorithm is designed basically for jobbing:

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
