MARKET COMMENTARY

The barometer index, the BSE Sensex, rose 220.03 points or 0.55% to 40,051.87. The Nifty 50 index rose 57.25 points or 0.49% to 11,844.10.

In the broader markets, the S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.65% while the S&P BSE Small-Cap index rose 0.36%.

The market breadth was positive. On the BSE, 1384 shares rose and 1119 shares fell. A total of 170 shares were unchanged.

In the past four trading sessions, the S&P BSE Sensex jumped 2.64% from its recent closing low of 39,020.39 on Thursday, 24 October 2019. The Nifty jumped 2.26% from its recent closing low of 11,582.60 on Thursday, 24 October 2019.

 - Wall Street falls on fresh trade jitters: - U.S. stocks dropped on Thursday as uncertainty around a potential trade deal between United States and China overshadowed strong earnings reports from Apple and Facebook.
 - ➤ U.S. Dollar Remains Lackluster After Fed Rate Cut: The U.S. dollar remained lower against other currencies on Thursday after falling during the prior session when the Federal Reserve cut rates by 25 basis points and failed to give clarity on further easing.
 - **Gold Prices Rise as Investors Renew** Easing Bets After Fed Move: - Gold prices rose on Thursday on perceptions that slowing global growth means that the trend to lower interest rates remains intact, even after the Federal Reserve appeared to put any further easing on hold for the foreseeable future. Treasury yields also fell on lingering uncertainties over the U.S.-China trade dispute, despite President Donald Trump reassuring via Twitter that the so-called 'phase-1' deal – a temporary truce that does little address the underlying causes of the dispute - is still on track to be signed in the coming weeks. The U.S. two-year yield fell eight basis points to 1.55%, while the 10-year fell 10 basis points to 1.70%.
 - ➢ OPEC October oil output jumps on swift Saudi recovery: Reuters survey: - OPEC oil output has bounced in October from an eight-year low as a rapid recovery in Saudi Arabian production from attacks on oil plants more than offset losses in Ecuador and voluntary curbs under a supply pact, a Reuters survey found.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

This Trading algorithm is designed basically for jobbing:

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage


Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
