MARKET COMMENTARY

Key equity indices declined on Tuesday, as investors locked profits after seven-day rising streak. The barometer index, the BSE Sensex fell 53.73 points or 0.13% to close at a 40,248.23. The Nifty 50 index fell 24.10 points or 0.20% to close at a 11,917.20.

In the broader market, the S&P BSE Mid-Cap index fell 1.13% while the S&P BSE Small-Cap index fell 0.80%. Both these indices underperformed the Sensex.

The market breadth was weak. On the BSE, 989 shares rose and 1505 shares fell. A total of 162 shares were unchanged.

 - ➤ Wall Street Inch Higher as Mixed Earnings Offsets Trade Hopes: Wall Street inched higher on Tuesday as mixed earnings releases offset rising hopes of a trade deal between Washington and Beijing, fueled by newspaper reports suggesting the U.S. is ready to compromise on some of China's core demands.
 - ➤ Dollar Rises Against Safe Haven Yen on Trade Deal Hopes: - The U.S. dollar was higher against the safe haven Japanese yen on Tuesday amid hopes that the U.S. and China are getting closer to a preliminary agreement to resolve their protracted trade war, which has raised fears of a global economic slowdown.
 - ▶ Gold Falls Again as Risk Appetite Builds on Trade Hopes: - Gold futures finally cracked Tuesday as growing hopes of a U.S.-China trade truce encouraged more and more market participants to move out of haven assets. Yields on other haven assets such as government bonds rose to their highest in nearly a week, with the 10year and 30-year U.S. Treasury yields both gaining six basis points to reach 1.85% and 2.34% respectively.
 - ➤ Oil Prices Rise on Hopes for U.S.China Trade Agreement: Oil prices
 climbed on Tuesday boosted by hopes
 for a U.S.-China trade deal and
 optimism that the Trump administration
 could roll back some of the tariffs it has
 imposed on Chinese imports. Earlier on
 Tuesday the Organization of the
 Petroleum Exporting Countries released
 its 2019 World Oil Outlook, in which the
 group said it would supply a diminishing
 amount of oil in the next five years as
 output of U.S. shale and other rival

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

Pre Defined Stop Loss


Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
