MARKET COMMENTARY

In the broader market Friday, the S&P BSE Mid-Cap index rose 0.18% while the S&P BSE Small-Cap index rose 0.32%. Both these indices outperformed the Sensex.

The market breadth was positive. On the BSE, 1430 shares rose and 1163 shares fell. A total of 174 shares were unchanged.

The Nifty edged higher in early trade but soon witnessed profit booking at higher level. Selling pressure in morning trade dragged the index lower as it hit the day's low of 11,843.55. The 50-unit recovered from lows in early afternoon trade and remained range bound for most part of the day. The Nifty finally managed to end a tad below 11,900-mark.

 - ➤ Wall Street Opens Down; Uber Hits New Low as Lockup Ends: - Wall Street fell on Wednesday as a lack of fresh news from the U.S.-China trade war left a flurry of mixed earnings in focus.
 - ➤ U.S. Dollar Falls Slightly on Lack of Trade News: The U.S. dollar was lower on Wednesday as a lack of fresh news on the U.S-China trade war front gave investors a reason to pause. Hopes of a breakthrough in the coming weeks had caused the dollar and U.S. equity markets to skyrocket, but that momentum has paused on a lack of substantial news.
 - > EIA reports a nearly 8 million-barrel weekly climb in U.S. crude-oil **supplies**: - The Energy Information Administration on Wednesday reported that U.S. crude supplies climbed by 7.9 million barrels for the week ended Nov. 1. Crude supplies were forecast to increase by 2.7 million barrels, according to analysts polled by S&P Global Platts. The EIA data also showed supply declines of 2.8 million barrels for gasoline and 600,000 barrels for distillates. The S&P Global Platts survey showed expectations for supply decreases of 2.4 million barrels for gasoline and 1 million barrels for distillates.
 - ➤ Gold Bounces After Tuesday Slide as Risk Rally Pauses: Gold prices corrected higher Wednesday after a sharp slide on Tuesday, as the rally in risk assets paused for breath in the absence of major fresh news on the U.S.-China trade front. Stock markets have hit a succession of new highs in recent days as various reports have talked up the prospect of an interim

SBS Stands for Simple Buying and Selling

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

This Trading algorithm is designed basically for jobbing:

Pre Defined Stop Loss
Pre Defined Risk
Buy-Sell Both
Carry Forward



Arbitrage

Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
