MARKET COMMENTARY

The Nifty ended below 12,200 mark. Gains in the HDFC twins and IT major Infosys offset losses in IndusInd Bank, Reliance Industries and Titan Company. Trading activity remained thin amid New Year holiday in major global stock markets.

The barometer index, the BSE Sensex, rose 52.28 points or 0.13% to 41,306.02. The Nifty 50 index rose 21.25 points or 0.17% to 12,189.70.

In the broader market, the S&P BSE Mid-Cap index advanced 0.21% while the BSE Small-Cap index gained 0.64%.

 - Wall Street edges higher; S&P closes decade with nearly 190% gain: - Wall Street's major indexes edged higher on Tuesday on a renewed rally fueled by trade optimism, capping off a decade of handsome returns in which the benchmark S&P 500 rose nearly 190%. Both the S&P 500 and the Nasdaq notched their biggest annual percentage gains since 2013, while the Dow closed 2019 with its biggest yearly percentage gain since 2017. In 2019, the current bull run in U.S. stocks became the longest one on record as trade optimism, dovish monetary policy and an improving economic outlook fueled sharp gains.
 - Optimism on trade and global growth knock dollar: - The euro, the pound and a clutch of trade-sensitive currencies rallied as the dollar slid to a six-month low on Tuesday, as investor confidence in global growth prospects and the Phase 1 U.S.-China trade deal spurred a risk-on move.
 - Yuan hits multi-month highs as economy shows signs of stabilization: - The Chinese yuan hit almost five-month highs and the USD continued to retreat on the last day of the year in Asia.
 - ➢ Oil Dips as 2019 Ends; Big Gains on Year, Big Challenges Ahead: - Oil prices fell on the last day of 2019, but still rounded the year out with the biggest annual gains in three. A rebound forecast in U.S. shale crude production could, however, pose greater challenges for the market in 2020.
 - Gold Back Above \$1,520; Gains as Much as 18% for 2019: - Gold capped out an unusually strong finish to 2019 despite the absence of more U.S.

The act or practice of buying stocks only to resell them at a profit very quickly. Stock jobbing is a short-term investment strategy that operates on the assumption or existence of liquid markets.

Arbitrage


Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example
As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
