The barometer BSE S&P Sensex plunged 893.99 points or 2.32% to 37,576.62, its lowest closing level since 7 October 2019. It fell as much as 1459.52 points at the day's low of 37,011.09 in mid-morning trade.

The Nifty 50 index plummeted 279.55 points or 2.480/0 to 10,989.45, its lowest closing level since 19 September 2019. It fell as much as 441.60 points at the day's low of 10,827.40 in mid-morning trade.

 Again: Volatility continued to
 dominate Wall Street trading Friday,
 with stocks lower but swinging around
 on a myriad of headlines regarding the
 global impact of Covid-19. Investors are
 dealing with a disease that is rapidly
 spreading, government responses whose
 effectiveness is questionable,
 bureaucratic standoffs in the case of
 OPEC and Russia, and a real ambiguity
 on whether good economic data is really
 good news given interest rate
 expectations.
 - Dollar Extends Losses as Rate Premium Withers: - The dollar extended its slide in early trading in Europe on Friday, as the prospect of collapsing U.S. interest rates continued to erode its appeal vis-à-vis its peers.
 - Poil Tumbles 9% to 4-Year Low as Russia Lets Down OPEC on Cuts: Oil suffered one of its worst crashes in a day, falling 9% to send U.S. crude prices to four-year lows, after reports that Russia has refused to back Saudi Arabia and other allies in OPEC on deeper production cuts to offset demand lost to the novel coronavirus. OPEC+, which includes Russia and other oil producing countries that aren't outright members of the cartel, issued a statement after talks in Vienna, saying it would continue consultations to stabilize the oil market.
 - ➢ Gold Nears \$1,700 Before Sliding; Still Biggest Week in 11 Years: -Gold came within striking distance of \$1,700 per ounce on Friday as fears over the growing coronavirus contagion drove investors worldwide toward safe havens, setting the yellow metal up for its best week in 11 years, before profittaking set in.


Arbitrage Stands for Simple Buying and Selling stocks but in another exchange. A Simple Arbitrage Example As a simple example of arbitrage, consider the following. The stock of Company X is trading at 100 on the NSE while, at the same moment, it is trading for 100.50 on the BSE. A trader can buy the stock on the NSE and immediately sell the same shares on the BSE, earning a profit of .50 per share.
